 To the appropriations entered in this item must be added the contribution from the EFTA States pursuant to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, and in particular Article 82 thereof and Protocol 32 thereof. By way of information, those amounts derive from contributions from the EFTA States entered against Article 6 J 0 of the statement of revenue, which constitute assigned revenue in accordance with Article 183(6) of the Financial Regulation; they give rise to the provision of corresponding appropriations and to implementation according to Annex V to this part of the statement of expenditure of this section, which forms an integral part of the general budget.

- ☞ How will the Partnership operate
- ☞ Establish the Work Packages that comprise the Work Programme
- ☞ The Project needs to be Time-Limited

- ☞ Be Clear about the Outputs of the Project
- ☞ What will happen at the end of the Project – Sustainability
- ☞ How the Project will be Evaluated
- ☞ How the Project Activities/Outcomes will be Disseminated
