Description for each work task

Mostly older people

Liaison Officers – set up:


LO set up: No Navy Base close to Esbjerg

CLO hand picked 1 year in advance from private shipping company - maritime background, knowledge of Port of Esbjerg, manager skills

LO centre (4 persons) recruited by CLO

70 ships

70 Liaison Officers in February - 7 months before



Requirements for Liaison Officers:

Responsible, however humble for new things Positive, flexible Representative - clothes, clean, alcohol, attitude Good health – long walking distances Participate in information meetings Bring own mobile phone – refund possible Facebook 2018: work in evenings



Liaison Officers – recruitment:

Recruitment of LOs via Facebook, network and brochures Application form, personal description and experience Many repeaters from 2001 and 1993 (and 2014) 120 applicants -> 70 Liaison Officers 2018: Former trainees Conclusion: Mix of age, experience and gender Average age: 41

Mail correspondance


Facebook group

Information meetings:

- Start May 4 months before + additional meeting
- End June 2 months before (teams set)
- End July 1 week before (last instructions, clothes, LO manual, guided tour on harbour)

2018: Danish Police Intelligence – extra meeting/longer meetings







Liaison Officers – team set up

- 8 teams
- 8-9 people per team
- 1 team coordinator
- A, B, C and D ships in each team
- Experienced and non-experienced
- Women and men
- Young and old
- Meetings in each group



Jobs for Liaison Officers:

Call system – special stand by team for first ships First visit on board, 2-3 visits per day

Social activities for crew

Daily morning briefings Team coordinator daily briefing Hospitality - events





Gains for Liaison Officers:

Ships:

Class A ships – two Liaison Officers on most class A's Class B, C and D ships – one Liaison Officer

Preferable with native speakers (or knowledge of the specific language)

Needs of each ship very individual (STI mobile office, hand out programmes, help LOs in need)







Reflections:

Treat all volunteers the same way! Good instructions, ask them to be flexible. Changes will happen

Timing, not too early – not too late

Food, clothes and shelter is essential

Appreciate their work – go and visit them Create an environment of resposible and independent

volunteers – with no need for interaction during the event A BIG PARTY 😳

A little (food or drink) surprise is always good 🤤
