- 2011: Approx. 450,000 visitors












The Tall Ships Races 2018 Stavanger





Stavanger, Norway

- Coastal city founded in year 1125

- 132,000 inhabitants (region: 330,000)
- 21 % non-Norwegian, 181 nationalities

Trainees - heart of our project
