Stavanger is the fourth largest city in Norway with 133.000 citizens, and the country's third largest urban area.

2.4 / Procedures

All ships must contact Kvitsøy VTS when approaching the coast line as described under item 2.2 above.

ETA Stavanger must be reported to Stavanger Port Authority and Technical Help Desk minimum 24 hrs prior to arrival.

When passing the point Tungenes, all ships must contact Stavanger Port Authority (VHF channel 27) for mooring instructions.

Departure / Parade of Sails:

All ships must listen to VHF channel 18 for messages/traffic. No reporting is necessary for the departure.

2.5 / Pilots

Pilotage is free of charge for all ships participating in The Tall Ships Races.

Pilots are compulsory inside the Norwegian coast base line for ships exceeding 70 metres.

Request for pilotage is included in the SafeSea-Net (SSN) template and must be sent to the Technical Help Desk by e-mail (tsrhelpdesk2018@gmail.com) prior to departure from Esbjerg or 48 hours prior to arrival in the first port in Norway. Pilotage for further voyage(s) towards Stavanger and departure from Stavanger must be ordered separately via the SSN template as soon as possible and at the latest 30 hrs before pilot is required.

On arrival, a final reporting must be made to Kvitsøy Pilot Station, VHF channel 13, two hours prior to arrival at the Pilot Station.

On departure, a final reporting must be made to the Technical Help Desk minimum 3 hrs prior to the required pilot boarding.

2.6 / Tugs

Tug assistance, if required and ordered, is free of charge both on arrival and on departure from Stavanger harbour. Tug assistance is not included for daily sailings.

Requirement for tug on arrival must be ordered via tsrhelpdesk2018@gmail.com prior to departure from Esbjerg or otherwise minimum 48 hrs prior to arrival in Stavanger.

2.7 / Customs & Immigration

All formalities towards Norwegian Customs, Coastal Authorities and Immigrations will be taken care of by the Technical Help Desk of The Tall Ships Races 2018 Stavanger.

A SafeSeaNet (SSN) template (in Excel format), including all necessary information for the ships, will be handed out on a USB stick at the Captains' Briefing in Esbjerg 20 July.

This template includes crew/passenger lists. Each ship will be requested to complete one SSN template for the first Norwegian port and an additional one for departure Stavanger, containing updated crew lists.

The arrival SSN template must be sent to the Technical Help Desk by e-mail (tsrhelpdesk2018@gmail.com) prior to departure from Esbjerg or 48 hours prior to arrival at the first port in Norway.

The departure SSN template must be sent to the Technical Help Desk by e-mail (tsrhelpdesk2018@gmail.com) within 18:00 hrs LT on Saturday 28 July.

In addition, if any crew change in Stavanger, the Captain must send an e-mail to Immigrations (svg.grensekontrollen@politiet.no) and Customs (Valborg.K.Bishop@toll.no) on departure from Stavanger containing name, nationality and DOB of all off-signers and on-signers.

Ships not calling at Esbjerg will be sent this SSN template by e-mail and must follow the same instructions for arrival at the first Norwegian port, and other formalities, as described in this manual.

2.8 / Security

There are no special security requirements. Ships with ISSC are required to exchange DOS with Port of Stavanger.

2.9 / Safety and Evacuation Plan

The safety and evacuation plan will be exchanged between the Port and the individual ships upon arrival in Stavanger.

This is an important document and we expect all participants to take time to understand it. Please also take note that this document should not be shared on a common basis. It should be treated as a confidential document.



3. Berthing

3.1 / Special Berthing Instructions

Berths have been arranged and assigned in advance for all participating ships. In order to facilitate departure for the Parade of Sails, all ships are requested to berth as shown in the enclosed Berthing Plan. Most ships will be turned upon arrival, i.e. bow heading out of harbour.

Call Stavanger Port Authority on VHF channel 27, or telephone +47 51 50 12 01 for additional assistance.

Fenders & Gangways

Ships are expected to provide their own fenders and means of access to shore. If fenders and gangways were requested in the STI Data sheet upon entering the races, fenders and gangways will be provided free of charge.

Technical Help Desk

The Technical Help Desk will be your "one stop shop" for all requirements for bunkering, stores, supplies, repairs etc. Services to be ordered on separate forms via tsrhelpdesk2018@gmail.com or in some cases via the Liaison Officer.

3.2 / Formalities

Dress Ship: All participating ships are kindly requested to dress ship Rainbow Fashion during the stay in Stavanger.

Colours: From 08:00 to 21:00 hours.

Official Norwegian flag day:

Sunday 29 July - Olsok. Olav's Mass in memory of King Olav Haraldsson (the Holy), who died in the battle of Stiklestad 29 July 1030.

3.3 / Crew Parade whistle

The Crew Parade is on Friday 27 July at 16-17 and will include a stop, where all ships are encouraged to greet their crew with the ship's whistle. Inform you crew on watch and make them aware to be on standby to blow the ship's whistle.

3.4 / Fireworks

There will be a firework display above the harbour on Saturday 28 July at 23:00-23:15. Some fireworks might be fired close to the tall ships. Fire guards on board are advisable during the display.

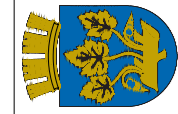
3.5 / Sale of alcohol

All sales of alcohol in Norway require a municipal licence. Ships planning to sell alcohol from their bonded stores during their visit to Stavanger must apply for such a licence well in advance. Should you require such a licence please inform us by contacting hedvig@tallships.no as soon as possible. The captain will be responsible for such sales and must be on board during any event where alcohol is being served and consumed.

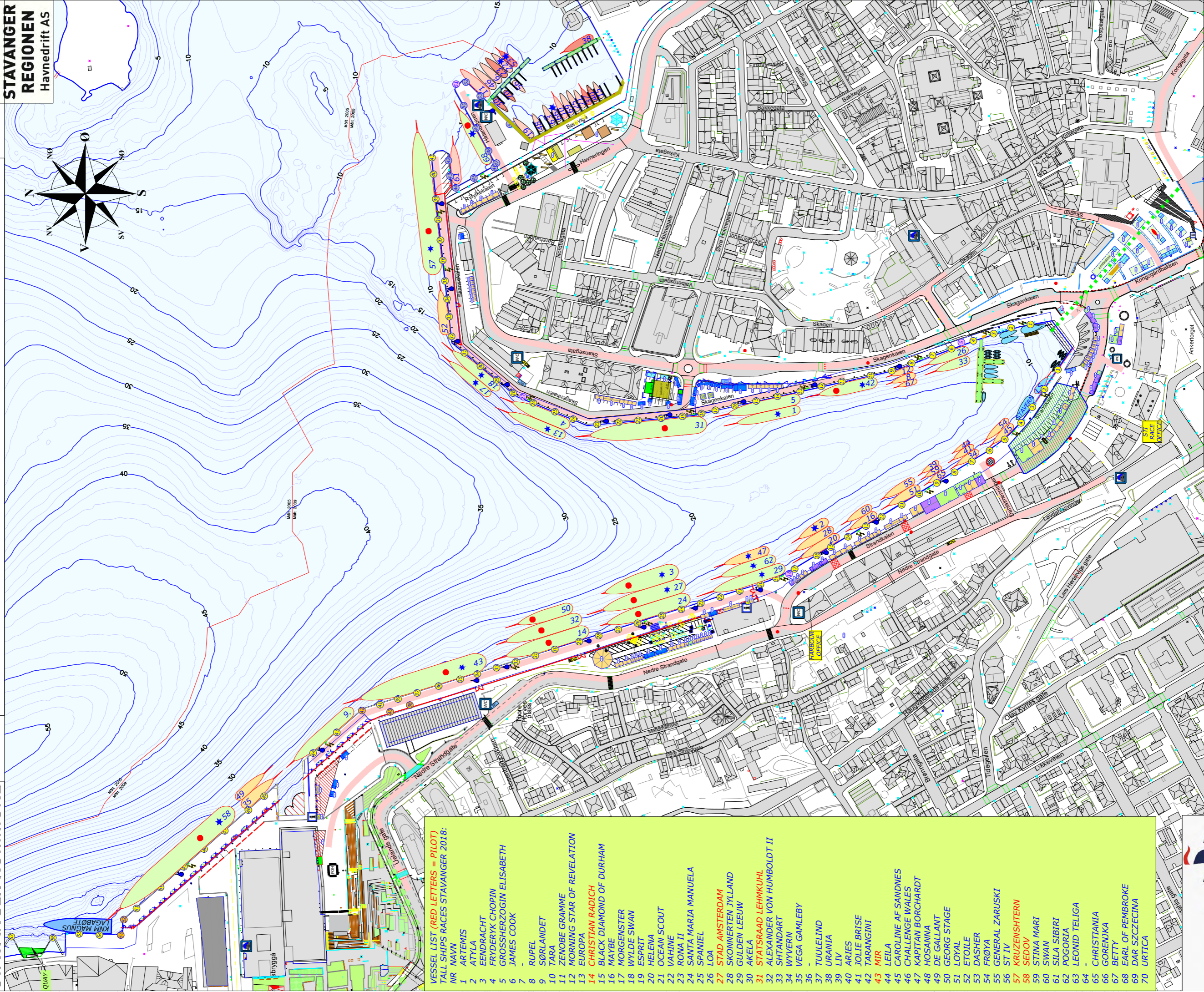

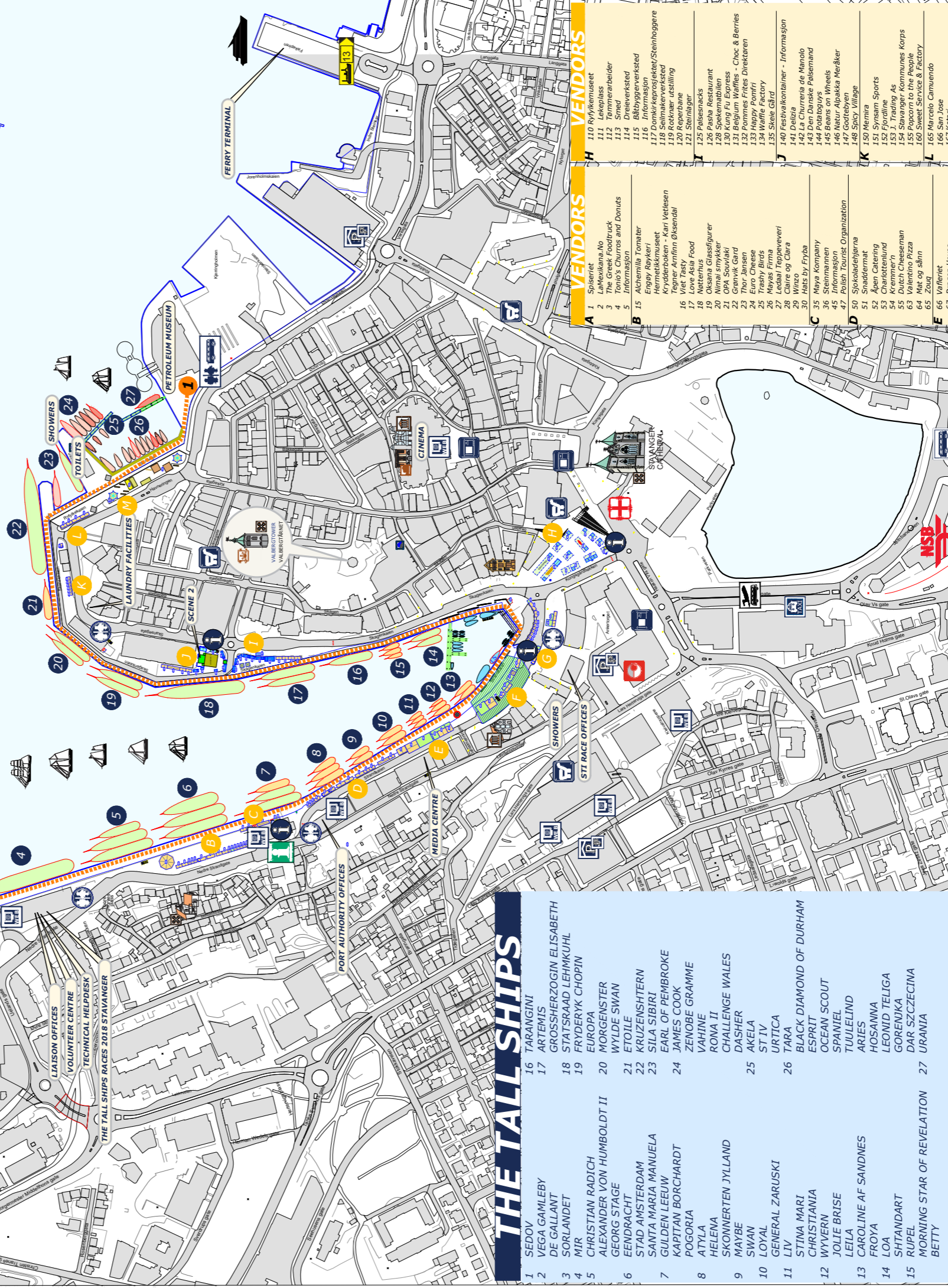
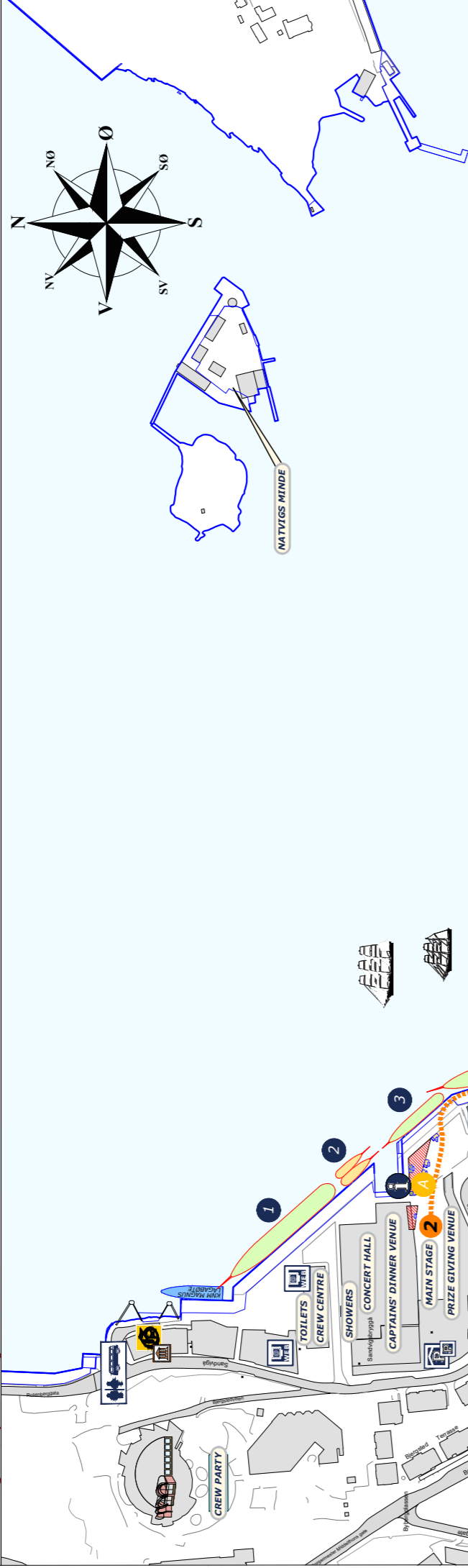


CAPTAINS MAP

- Anyone over 18 supplying alcohol to under 18s or anyone under 18 drinking alcohol inside the party area will be asked to leave immediately.
- Crew over 18 will have to show Crew Party wrist band and ID to be served any alcohol.

Ship's crew is responsible for fuelling and must assure no spillage.

Only major credit cards will be accepted.

9.2 / Water

Water posts with hoses, **for self-service**, will be available along the quayside. Water supply is free of charge.

9.3 / Electrical power supply

9.4 / Disposal of general waste and special waste – oil pollution

Larger volumes of general waste can be collected at the gangway before 10:00 hrs LT on Thursday morning 26 July.

Orders for general waste collection must be sent 48 hrs prior to arrival by e-mail to Technical Help Desk (tsrhelpdesk2018@gmail.com).

Otherwise, waste is to be delivered to the environmental stations in the quay area, each divided into the following categories:

- Organic Waste
- Glass/Metal
- Paper/Cardboard
- Mixed Plastic

IMPORTANT!!! Any food contaminated waste must be treated as general waste.

Emptying of environmental stations will be carried daily between 06:00 and 10:00 hrs.

General waste can be disposed of in waste containers along the quay area.

General waste disposal is free of charge.

Special waste may be collected for disposal, as per order form. Order by e-mail to the Technical Help Desk (tsrhelpdesk2018@gmail.com).

Oil pollution legislation imposes strict prohibition over any discharge of oily mixtures. Any ship causing or sighting such pollution is obliged to immediately report all details to the Port Authority. The Liaison Officer should also be informed.

Gas bottles will be refilled on Friday and Saturday mornings. The empty propane gas bottles must be marked with the ship's name and phone number, then placed on the quay by the gangway for collection at 06:00 hrs LT on Friday and/or Saturday.

The bottles will be filled and returned to the ship before 10:00 hrs LT the same day.

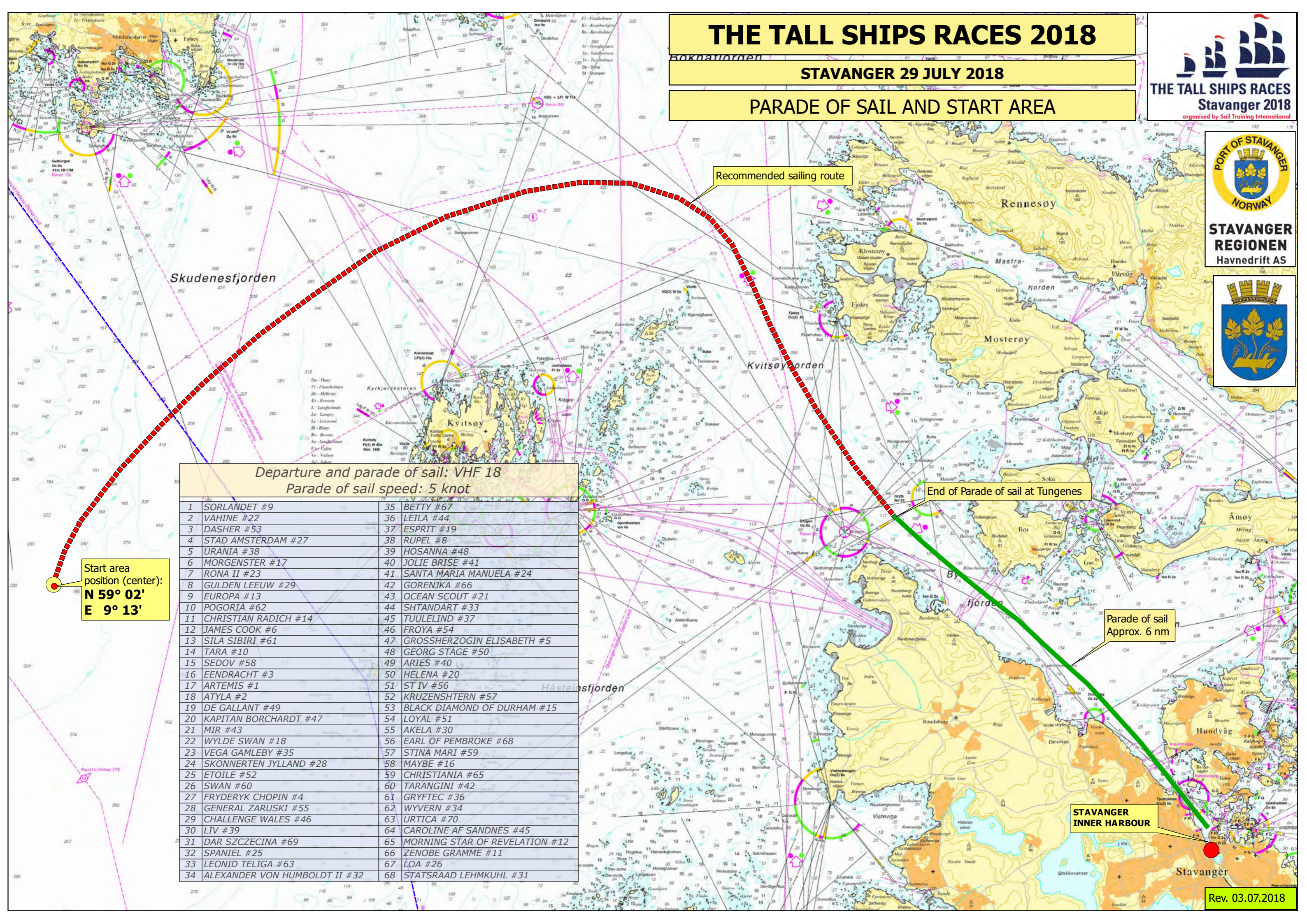

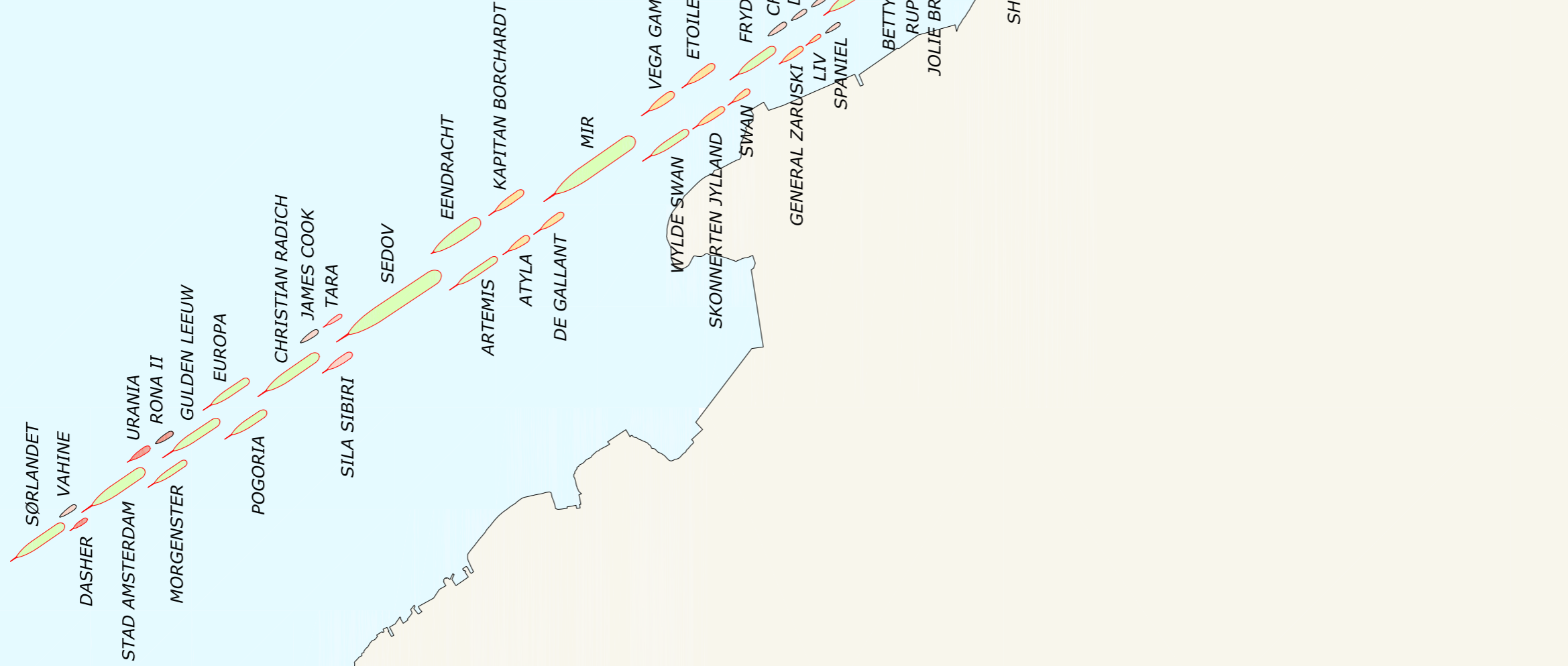
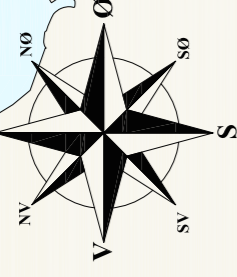
