SEATRIBE PASSAGE TO THE FUTURE

Sea tribe – passage to the future (2018-2020) is a joint project of Y-foundation and STAF, funded by Centre for Social Welfare and Health Organizations (STEA). It focuses on strengthening (working-) life- and social skills of 18-30-year-old young adults who are in risk of social exclusion and are starting their independent lives. Our aim is to develop a model which effectively reduces loneliness, social exclusion and helps people in our target group to get back on track and eventually move on to working life. This is done by combining methods of sail training, adventure education, peer-to-peer -support and social case management.


HOW THEY DEFINE THEMSELVES;
