ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

Entrance

After having passed the finishing line at «Færder» lighthouse, proceed to Fredrikstad port.

For approach to Fredrikstad, information will be provided at Captains Briefing in Aalborg.

Recommended Western approach for all vessels with draft less than 4 meters.

Ships recommended to use western approach to Port of Fredrikstad ought to sail either east of «Southern Søster» or North of «Struten» light house in to «Lera». From «Lera» recommended fairway is on either side of «Torgauten» and north with «Gåsungene» light on your port bow. After this light the river starts. Be aware of strong current in the river.

Further, it's referred to recommended fairway marked in the charts.

Recommended Eastern approach for all vessels with draft more than 4 meters.

Ships recommended to use Eastern approach to port of Fredrikstad should sail South of «Trestenene» light (N 50' 01,5" E 10' 54,1"). The fairway is South end East of «Vidgrunn» light.

Further approach refer to recommended fairway marked in the chart. This is the main approach to the Port of Fredrikstad. Be aware of much traffic in this fairway.

After passing «Belgen» light the river starts. Be aware of strong currant in the river.

According to agreement with pilot.

BRIDGES

Note slot times for bridge openings. For those that arrive via the fairway West, the following slot times for the Værste bridge apply:

Wednesday 10th July 04:00 - 06.00

09:00 - 11:00 18:00 - 19:00 21:00 - 23:00

Thursday 11th July 09:00 - 11:00

For departure, the slot time for the Værste bridge is:

Sunday 14th July 10:00 - 11:00

For departure, the slot time for the Kråkerøy and pedestrians' bridges is:

Sunday 14th July 14:30 - 16:30

Bridges will not be opened outside of stipulated slot times.

CUSTOMS

The following forms must be handed over to the LO upon departure from Aalborg:

- Crew list with passport numbers
- Custom Declaration for Cruise Ships

The Race Office will collect these forms from the LOs and hand over to Fredrikstad´s representative in Aalborg.

Masters are advised to retain a copy on board for inspection in case Customs Officers wish to board your vessel. It is forbidden to sell any imported goods on the quayside alongside the ships.

Customs officers may inspect ships for prohibited goods.

PILOTS

Pilots will be provided free of charge, to all vessels that apply.

Pilots are compulsory inside the Norwegian coast baseline for ships exceeding 70 metres.

Request for pilotage should be done through the SafeSeaNet (SSN) template (https://www.kystverket.no/en/EN Maritime-Services/Pilot-Services/Book-a-Pilot/).

Alternatively via the agent, Andersen and Mørck, operation@andmork.no, agency department (+47) 69 35 85 15.

Duty (24 hours) (+47) 90 13 21 90.

On arrival, a final call must be made to Horten VTS, VHF channel. 18, two hours prior to arrival at the Pilot boarding area.

The Pilot-boat must be called 1/2 an hour prior to arrival to the Pilot station, VHF Ch 12, Phone 909 75 831.

Pilotage for departure Fredrikstad must be ordered separately via SSN template as early as possible and latest 30 hrs before pilot is required, alternatively by contacting agent as above.

IMMIGRATION

It is the responsibility of the individuals concerned to obtain any visas they may need. Failure to be in possession of such documents may have implications for them and the operators of the host vessel.

All crew members/passengers must hold a valid passport and visa where applicable. Most visitors

from countries outside the EU/EEA must apply for a visitor's visa: https://www.udi.no/en/want-to-apply/visit-and-holiday/.

Failure to be in possession of a valid visa may render the person liable to removal from Norway at the vessel´s expense.

BERTHING

Berthing in accordance with Pilot's advice. Assistance by tugs will be available for the larger vessels. For other vessels assistance from a small tug and/or RIBs will be available. Mooring crew will be available for all vessel mooring alongside.

When approaching Fredrikstad, vessels will have to navigate eastbound into Glomma River, or westbound into Vesterelven. The fairways are well marked with lights, buoys and leading lights. The depth in Glomma River is 9.9 mtrs., in Vesterelven 4 mtrs.

City ordinance requires that quiet must obtain in docking areas after 23:00

Toilet facilities are located at the Crew Centre and several other locations around the city (see map)

MONEY EXCHANGE

Please note that banks in Fredrikstad do not exchange cash.

LIAISON SYSTEM

Every ship will be met by its dedicated Liaison Officer upon arrival.

The LO will be at your service every day and will visit your ship according to you need.

You may call the LO when needed. Many of the services you may need, should be requested through your LO.

SHIP SERVICES

Fuel

May be ordered through the LO-office prior to arrival. Norwegian regulations stipulate that it is not allowed to fill fuel on export. Smaller vessels may get fuel with credit card at the guest harbour (Værste) which they pass on their way into town.

Water

Fresh water will be provided from shore or from barge, but will be restricted. Limited for the largest ships. Water filling will be self-serve, using established "water-points" and/or requested through the LO (please use Water Requisition Form, appendix 2)

Electricity

All C and D vessels will have free access to external power, as will Class B ships, but they must notify the port according to previously communicated guidelines.

Waste will be segregated in 5 different categories:


- Garbage. Black plastic bags to be used. Collected at dock daily 06:00 10.00
- Gray water. May go overboard
- Slop (oily water). Order through LO one day prior to service delivery (cash payment only)
- Hazardous waste (paint, oil, chemicals). Order through LO one day prior to service delivery (cash payment only)
- Sewage. Order through LO one day prior to service delivery (cash payment only)

Please use Ship's Waste Declaration, appendix 1.

Oil pollution legislation imposes strict prohibition over any discharge of oily mixtures. Any ship causing or sighting such pollution is obliged to immediately report all details to the Port Authorities. The LO should also be informed.
