## **RECOMMENDED CREW CHANGE DATES**

**It is strongly recommended that crew changes are conducted on the THIRD day of the official port dates.** Our experience is that trainees who have to leave their vessel before the prize-giving and crew party feel they are being deprived of an important part of the whole "experience" and would much prefer to have the chance to stay for those events, even if it means having to travel late at night or early in the morning.
