1	The SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2020 is organised by Tall Ships Races International Limited, a wholly owned Sail Training International company.
2	If necessary ships may be entered for a part of the Regatta only, i.e. Race 1 or Race 2. It is preferred however, if ships do the whole Regatta.
3	The races are Category 1, in accordance with the current edition of Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations.
4	Composition of crew. For The SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2020, whilst no upper age limits are imposed, all race entries are encouraged to recruit trainees between the ages of 15 and 25 years. No person under the age of 15 years is to be on board during the Race unless approved by the Race Committee. For further details see Sail Training International's Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations.
5	The minimum water line length for all vessels is 9.14m (30ft).
6	VHF radio and a type approved 406MHz EPIRB are compulsory for these races.
7	Late entries after 1 June 2020 may be accepted subject to the approval of the Race Committee.

I/We UNDERSTAND that the Race Committee may not permit my/our vessel to take part in the race if they in their absolute discretion consider my/our vessel or its crew not fit to take part in a race for any reason whatsoever and that the Race Committee shall not be obliged to give any reason for their decision.

I/We UNDERSTAND that an inspection by a representative of Tall Ships Races International Limited or a Race Official in accordance with the Special Regulations is no indication that Tall Ships Races International Limited has in any way agreed or certified that my/our vessel and/or its equipment is seaworthy which are matters entirely under the control of the Captain / Master.

I/We CONFIRM that my/our vessel is legally licensed and insured to sail with trainees and take part in all programmed activities whether in port or at sea (including racing) [as per rule 1.02.9 of the Special Regulations of the Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations].

I/We UNDERSTAND that Tall Ships Races International Limited reserves the right to require a letter of authority from the owners of any vessel in respect of any Captain/Master or other person if such owner wishes the Captain/Master to sign any declaration or other document on behalf of the vessel.

I/We AGREE that in any dispute or matter relating to the race, the decision of Tall Ships Races International Limited, or the Race Committee appointed by them, shall be final.

TIME CORRECTION FACTOR AND VESSEL MEASUREMENT FORM

Vessels taking part in the SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2020 are all rated. This allows them to race together regardless of size or rig. Vessels are placed in classes according to the current edition of Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations. In order for vessels to be rated, a comprehensive set of measurements is required to calculate the Time Correction Factor (TCF). Vessels that are new to the SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2020 and have not been rated, or those that want their rating verified, or that have altered their measurements in any way, should apply to the Race Office for a vessel measurement form. The measurements should be taken to the nearest 2 centimetres or 1 inch, and must be certified correct by a yacht designer, official measurer of the Royal Ocean Racing Club or similar national authority, a shipyard manager, the Race Director or a technical consultant of Sail Training International.

Vessels taking part in The SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2020 are required to stay in the host ports for all 'official visit' day as listed on the first page of this Entry Form. The official days start at 12 noon on the first day of each port visit and include the parade of sail on the day of departure, as this is an important event for the ports and is an occasion when we can thank the local people for their hospitality and kindness.

Vessel operators and captains/masters are to make sure that any sailing plans or charters scheduled to commence after their vessel has left The SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2020 should be designed so that their vessel can remain in port for the designated official days and does not have to leave early. Vessels deciding to leave early will have no assistance in doing so from the organisers and must expect to pay full commercial rates for tugs, pilots etc.
