

RULES FOR THE BOSTON TEAPOT TROPHY

CLOSING DATE: 1ST OCTOBER ANNUALLY

1. This trophy may be competed for annually by any vessel of any flag, provided that:
 - 1.1 The length of the waterline (LWL) is not less than 9.14m (30 ft).
 - 1.2 The following parts of the Racing and Sailing Rules, Current Edition must be observed during the period covered by the entry:

Part 1: Rule 1, Rule 21, Rule 24
Part 2: Sections 3, 4 and 5
Part 3: Rule 1, Section A
2. The trophy will be presented ANNUALLY to the vessel which, at any time **between 1st October and 30th September of the following year** covers the greatest corrected distance in any period of 124 hours (5 days 4 hours).
3. The distance claimed may be between two points and may include a maximum of two additional waypoints.
4. During the period concerned:
 - 4.1 The vessel may put into any port, but the time spent in harbour may NOT be deducted from the 124 hour period.
 - 4.2 The engine may be run, but the distance covered under power shall be deducted from the total distance. The time under power may NOT be deducted.
5. The owner, or captain/master, or any vessel wishing to compete for this trophy must send details of the passage concerned to the Race Director of Sail Training International **no later than 1st October in the year in which the passage was made**. An entry form is attached for this purpose and no entry will be accepted unless it is on this form.
