THE TALL SHIPS RACES 2022 VESSEL PARTICIPATION

Vessels taking part in The Tall Ships Races are required to stay in the host ports for all 'official visit' day as listed on the first page of this Entry Form. The official days start at 12 noon on the first day of each port visit and include the parade of sail on the day of departure, as this is an important event for the ports and is an occasion when we can thank the local people for their hospitality and kindness.

Vessel operators and captains/masters are to make sure that any sailing plans or charters scheduled to commence after their vessel has left. The Tall Ships Races should be designed so that their vessel can remain in port for the four designated official days and does not have to leave early. Vessels deciding to leave early will have no assistance in doing so from the organisers and must expect pay full commercial rates for tugs, pilots, etc.
