2	The races are <b>Category 1</b> , in accordance with the current edition of Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations.
3	The Regatta organisers reserve the right to refuse acceptance of an entry.
4	<b>Composition of crew. For the SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2021, whilst no upper age limits are imposed, all race entries are encouraged to recruit trainees between the ages of 15 and 25 years.</b>
5	<b>No person under the age of 15 is to be on board during a race unless approved by the Race Committee. For further details see current edition of Sail Training International Racing &amp; Sailing Rules &amp; Special Regulations.</b>
6	The minimum water line length for all vessels is 9.14m (30ft).
7	VHF radio and a type approved 406MHz EPIRB are compulsory for these races.
8	Late entries after 1 June 2021 may be accepted subject to the approval of the Race Committee.
9	A penalty may be charged if all information required for rating purposes is not submitted by the closing date for entries (1 June 2021).
10	A proportion of the entry fee may be returned if, after it has been paid or an entry form has been submitted, an owner or his representative decides that his vessel cannot take part, provided the cancellation is due to an unforeseeable situation.
11	This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.
12	The Time Correction Factor (TCF), its associated applications, including 'Gateway', are the intellectual property of Sail Training International (STI) and its subsidiary companies and as such must not be used or reproduced for any purpose other than participating in events organised by STI.

## THE SCF WHITE SAILS OF PEACE TALL SHIPS REGATTA 2021 – VESSEL PARTICIPATION

Vessels taking part in SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2021 are required to stay in the Host Ports for all 'official visit' days as listed on the first page of this entry form. The official days start at 12 noon on the first day of each port visit and include the parade of sail on the day of departure, as this is an important event for the ports and is an occasion when we can thank the local people for their hospitality and kindness.

Vessel operators and captains/masters are to make sure that any sailing plans or charters scheduled to commence after their vessel has left SCF White Sails of Peace Tall Ships Regatta 2021 should be designed so that their vessel can remain in port for the four designated official days and does not have to leave early. Vessels deciding to leave early will have no assistance in doing so from the organisers and must expect pay full commercial rates for tugs, pilots, etc.
