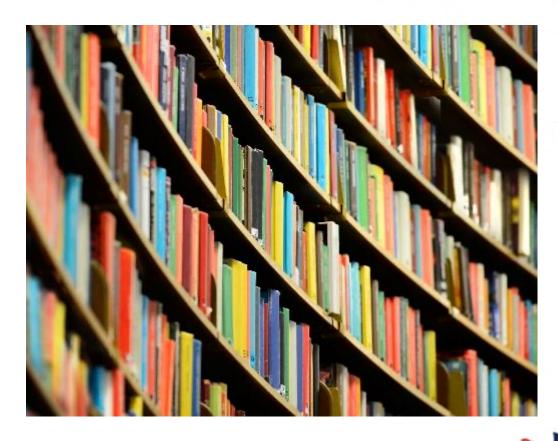
STI Research – The Year in Review

- Templates to help with your research

STI Research Working Group

- Conduct periodic surveys to identify desired research topics and explore the best way to achieve these
 outcomes.
- Identify and pursue research partners (universities, research houses, motivated individuals)
- Identify common data sets to aid future research projects.
- Analyse existing data to identify factors motivating youth to participate in a sail training voyage.
- Increase the scope of the STI research library and access to summaries.
- Explore connections between land-based and sea-based outdoor education.
- Explore future financial and non-financial support options to help support large- and small-scale research.
- Develop a framework/forum to help connect those looking to conduct research with those seeking to fund research.

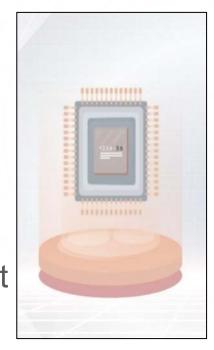

Research and Artificial Intelligence.

- The rise of AI in our society was not unexpected, yet the speed at which it has expanded has taken many by surprise.
- Its inclusion in everyday life and business is now inevitable.
- Clever, deliberate use of Al can accomplish in seconds what it may take hours, days or weeks for a human to complete.

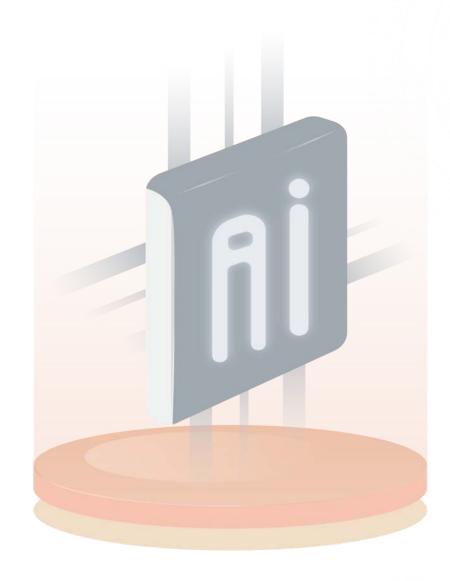

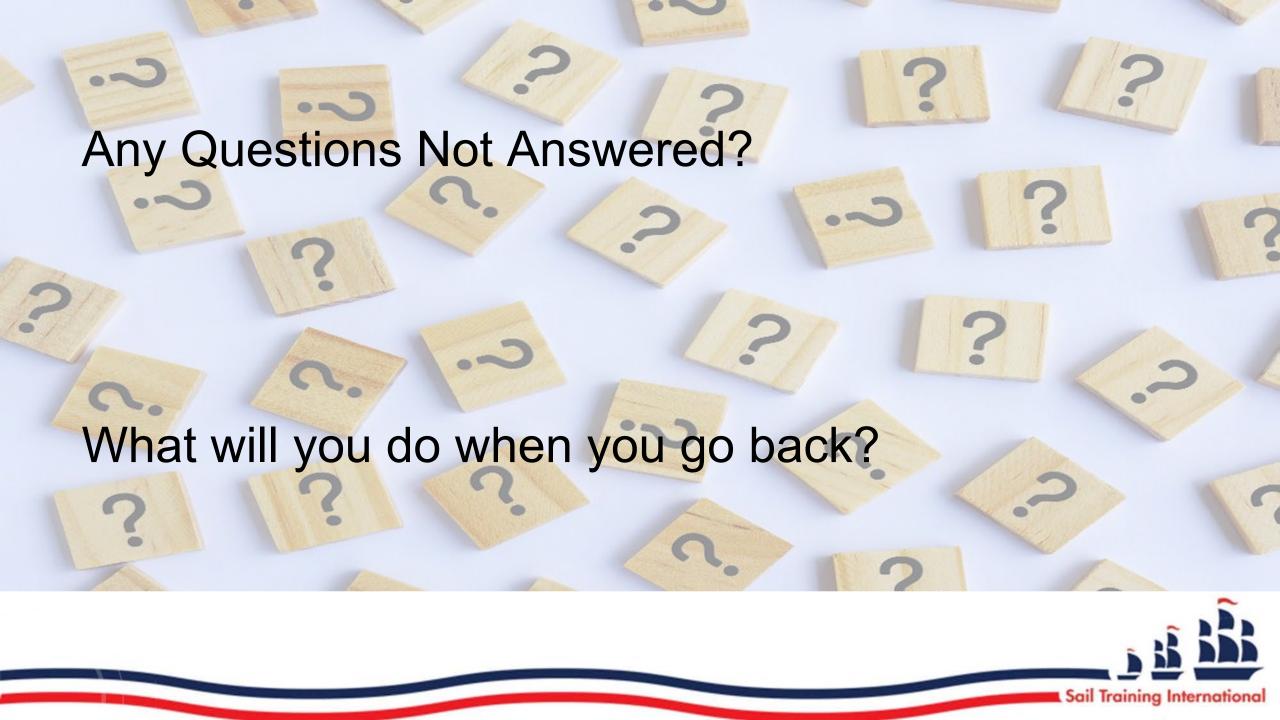
