



MAIN COLUMN

- •ALL TIMES IN LOCAL TIME (UTC+3)
- Undocking and parade radio communication VHF CH67
- •Parade commander's call sign PARADE1 (one) on the PILOT BOAT in the WAITING AREA 1
- •Fleet radio check 1035 (PARADE1 call: ETNA radio check. Answer: ETNA ready)
- •All vessels in main column **STAND-BY 1045** (warm engine and remaining minimum mooring lines)
- •FOLLOW-ME boat will give VISUAL signal for each vessel for undocking



MAIN COLUMN

- •All vessels in main column proceeding close to green buoys toward WAITING AREA 1 (pilot boat)
- •All vessels in parade keep **PILOT BOAT** on your **PORT SIDE**
- •First vessel of the parade in the **WAITING AREA 1** at **1130**
- •All vessels keep arranged order in **ORDER PLAN** and follow **LT NAVY SHIP N42 JOTVINGIS**
- •Radio watch on VHF CH67 keep until passing breakwaters

SMALLER C&D YACHTS

- ALL TIMES IN LOCAL TIME (UTC+3)
- Undocking and parade radio communication VHF CH67
- Parade commander's call sign PARADE1 (one) on the PILOT BOAT in the WAITING AREA 1
- 1015 all yachts STAND-BY (warm engine and remaining minimum mooring lines, ready pull line if necessary)
- FOLLOW-ME boat will give VISUAL signal for each vessel for undocking



SMALLER C&D YACHTS

- All yachts proceeding toward **WAITING AREA 2** free practice
- All yachts must be in **WAITING AREA 2** at **1130**
- S/Y LIETUVA joins on the STARBOARD side of S/V BONAWENTURA
- First yacht of the parade in the YACHTS COLUMN S/Y LIETUVA (leader)
- All yachts keep arranged order in **ORDER PLAN** and follow **S/Y LIETUVA by safe distance**
- Formation speed 5 KN
- Radio watch on VHF CH67 keep until passing breakwaters

First leg about 280 nm

The finish line of Race 1:

Port end 59° 35.0' N 024° 09.1' E Mid point 59° 33.2' N 024° 12.5' E Stb end 59° 31.4' N 024° 16.0' E A line bearing 315° T from Suurupi Rear Light For a distance of 5 to 10 NM

ATTENTION! Be aware for the possible GPS interference!



After race entering Finnish waters

Apr. 50 nm to Helsinki harbours. Continue to Uusmadal and then turning to North, sailing East of Porkkala Traffic Separation Scheme to Finnish territorial waters. Other possibility from Kuradimuna towards Harmaja.

Beware of the fast going (25 kn) ferry traffic between Helsinki and Tallinn. Tallink Mystar, Megastar and Finlandia sails West and Viking XPRS east of Helsinki lighthouse NORMALLY!

Tallink departures 7.30-23.00, Finlandia 6.00-21.40, Viking XPRS 8.00-21.15.


Entering Helsinki

Entering Helsinki via Harmaja lighthouse 9,6 m fairway. Call Helsinki VTS ch 71 when entering the area. Pilot boarding position Helsinki N 2 nm south of Harmaja, orders via Finnpilot. If sailing East of Harmaja, entering South of Hramtsow radar mark. If you want to sail in Finnish waters the best area for it is between Harmaja and Kalbådagrund (Porvoo) before harbour service hours.



15 min notice VTS ch 71 before entering. Helsinki VTS reports for other traffic.

No meeting or overtaking.

After Kustaanmiekka lots of water bus and pleasure craft traffic.









Entering South harbour

Turn to heading 298° after Lonna island 9,3m fairway towards South harbour between Katajanokka and Valkosaari.

Take lines from tugs either before Valkosaari or in South harbour basin. Tugs working ch 08.

Have your casting line ready, tow line from the tug. Tugs Rodney and Kalle.



LOs at your service from 3.7.



Berthing plan North harbour







Waste and recycling

- Remember waste sorting according to instructions in the Captains manual!
- Waste types collected are:

Mixed waste

Bio waste

Paper

Glass

Cardboard & carton

LPDE plastic

Consumer plastic

Food oil

Paint, battery, aerosol and other hazardous waste Note! All hazardous waste shall be reported 4.7. at latest to the LO!

 Note! Vessels above 400 gross tonnage on berths EPL and EKL, are obligated to make an advance waste notice to Port of Helsinki and order waste collection 24 hours before arrival.



Waste water disposal

Note! It is prohibited to discharge any kinds of waste, waste water, untreated or treated sewage or any other substances from ships into the sea.

Waste water emptying happens in Helsinki at arrival and before departure

All vessels having 38-50 mm deck filler for wastewater shall stop first on outer pier of Guest harbour Marina Bay for emptying.

Others continue to their own berthing places. Halkolaituri has its own wastewater system and others will be emptied by tank truck.

No drone zone

Opening Ceremony 4.7. Thursday

At 11.55 the Helsinki Cathedral will sound its bells to welcome the Tall Ships Races Fleet. Ringing of the Cathedral bells will end sharply at 12:00.

Upon that moment, all the Tall Ships vessels will sound their bells, horns and whistles for exactly 30 seconds to greet the new host port.

The ships are responding exactly at 12:00 GPS local time for 30 seconds.

Fuel order to LO 4.7 by 13.00. Delivery by small tanker on 5.7 morning.



You can make arrangements for food supplies for the vessel through our partner's good online store, https://www.k-ruoka.fi/ which will be delivered to the harbour the next morning.

The order must be placed by 12:00 PM the day before. If you want to order larger quantities (over 50 pieces per product), the online order must be placed at least 72 hours before delivery. We also wish an advanced notice from the vessels before departure from Klaipėda. Further information from harbourmaster and LOs at arrival.





Carbon footprint calculation

Host port Helsinki is working towards carbon neutrality and reduction.

The carbon footprint of the event is calculated.

All event operators are required to report the necessary information for the calculations.

The LOs will distribute forms for reporting the travel information of changing crew members (travels to and from Helsinki).




RACE START BASICS:

- Downwind start
- VHF 77
- Don't be early!
- CLASS A 20 MIN START GATE
- CLASS A RECORD YOUR INDIVIDUAL START TIME
- PLEASE STAY AWAY FROM THE START BOX UNTIL 20 MINS BEFORE START SIGNAL FOR THEIR CLASS
- ENGINE MUST NOT BE USED LESS THAN 20 MINS BEFORE THE START (UNLESS MORE THAN 1NM FROM THE START LINE)



Sat communications 0800 and 1700 UTC

Voice communications 0815 and 1715 UTC (VHF CH 77)

First Regular Comms Schedule 0815 UTC 1 July (Monday)



The communications officer will call each vessel as listed in the schedule.

Pass your Lat and Long when called: e.g: 55 27 08 26 (just degrees & minutes)

The communications officer will pass back your race placings (Class and Overall)

Any relevant weather information will be broadcast at the end of the schedule, along with any other race related information.

Please maintain Radio Silence during the schedules.

STBY COMMS VESSEL - URANIA

Any vessel not able to contact 'Race Control' by Radio can use any of the alternative methods:

- SMS to Race Director: +48 501 025 799
- Relay through another vessel (competing or commercial)
- Any other method



FINISHING THE RACE:

Pass your Finish Time (to the nearest second), future intentions, retirements and ETA for HELSINKI to RACE CONTROL

Remain on communications schedule until stood down by RACE CONTROL

THIS INCLUDES VESSELS THAT HAVE RETIRED AND VESSELS THAT HAVE FINISHED



FINISHING AT SEA:

The Race Committee monitors the fleet's progress and, if the fleet is expected to be late into HELSINKI, the RACE TIME LIMIT will be changed. The details to be broadcasted by RACE CONTROL.

At the new TIME LIMIT for your class, note your position and report it to RACE CONTROL.

Please do not retire!



If ONE Report Missed

Noted and STP may be awarded

If TWO Reports Missed

Concerned and another STP may be awarded

If THREE Reports Missed

another STP may be awarded and may be DSQ

MRCC may be informed and SAR considered
