2. ARRIVAL ARRANGEMENTS

2.1 Charts

Lithuanian chart No. LT 465020, LT562510; English chart No. AC 2276;

2.2 Frequencies

VHF channel 9 will be the port's principal operations frequency during event.

2.3 Call Signs

The Vessel Traffic Service Klaipeda VTS: call sign **Radio 5**, VHF **CH 9**, phone +370 46 499691.

State Border Guard Service call sign **IMPULS 3**, VHF CH **73**, phone +370 46 391169.

2.4 Procedures

All participating vessels are requested to establish contact on VHF channel 9 (call sign "Klaipėda radio-5") 2 hours prior to the arrival (or tel no. +370 46 499691). During this initial contact vessels should:

request the service of a pilot if required (see below);

be prepared to receive navigation information;

Following details are to be mentioned:

name of the vessel, call sign and flag;

maximum draft in fresh water;

ETA Klaipeda;

last port;

next port (after Klaipeda).

After entering in port, vessels up to 24 m, **must** be inform STATE BORDER GUARD SERVICE by VHF Ch 73 following info:

Vessel name, flag, POB, nationality of crew members.

2.5 Pilots

Ship agent is compulsory for the vessels more than 24 metres in length. Host port dedicated UAB Limarko Maritime Agency will provide free of charge ship agency services

6. Pilots

Pilotage is compulsory for the vessels more than 24 metres in length (in and out). However, if Klaipeda VTS allows vessels may not have a pilotage, or if acceptable, follow in the wake of the vessel with pilot on board. Pilots are free of charge.

2.6 Tugs

Tugs are free of charge for those ships if requested in advance. "FOLLOW ME" RIB's are also available for B, C, D classes.

2.7 Fuel, Fresh Water and Electricity

Riverside moored smaller than 24m in length vessels will be asked to bunker upon arrival at the filling station located at fuel berth pontoon on quay No. 45 Diesel and petrol available. Payment in cash or credit/debit cards.

Other riverside moored vessels will be serviced by road tanker. Bunkering of other A, B class vessels will be provided by a bunker boat alongside or road tanker. Payment on delivery. Please fill in Fuel requirement page of your Captain's manual and hand over to your Liaison Officer/Ship's Agent to for this service.

Fresh water will be available by barge, truck or (limited to 100 MT per vessel) filling up stations at berths free of charge but economy of use is requested.

Electricity is available free of charge on most quaysides, although large A class ships will be encouraged to use their own generators.

2.8 Waste Disposal and Pollution

Rubbish collection at the commercial port will be arranged by barge or truck. On other sites containers will be made available at various strategic points for household waste. These containers will be emptied every day. Ships should use their own garbage sacks. Waste sacks should be brought to waste containers by the crew members.

Sewage /Black Water – Advance notification with estimated volume is required prior to 24 July by email: valdemaras@seafestival.lt

You will have to notice of amount and types of waste your agent before arrival. All vessels will have to fill in waste disposal pages on their captain's manual.

Oil pollution legislation imposes strict prohibition over any discharge of oily mixtures. Any vessel causing or sighting such pollution is obliged to immediately report all details to the Port Authorities. The Liaison Officer should also be informed.

2.9 Customs & Immigration (Forms available in Section 10)

Vessels over 24 metres in length before departure of any other port at least 5 days before arrival in the Port of Klaipeda will be required to complete and send by email formal Ship's Declaration, Crew Lists and Crew Effects Declaration (using the Sail Training International Crew List form) to the Ship's agent and Organization office email: valdemaras.vizbaras@gmail.com

The same documents (4 copies of Crew Lists, 2 copies of Crew Effects Declarations, 2 copies of Ships Store Lists) should be given to ship's agent on arrival. Customs officers may inspect ships for prohibited goods at any time in the Port of Klaipėda.

For vessels less than 24 meters in length before departure of any other port at least 5 days before arrival in the Port of Klaipėda will be required to complete and send Crew Lists (using the Sail Training International Crew List form) to valdemaras.vizbaras@gmail.com
2 copies of Crew List should be given to ship's L.O. on arrival. You must have onboard filled-in Crew Effects Declaration and Ships Store Lists for inspection by Customs officers.

Please note that the Master is totally responsible for bonded stores.

All crew/passengers must hold a valid passport (ID) and visa where necessary.
Crew/passengers from countries with compulsory visa must apply for a visa in advance.
Failure to be in possession of such documents may have implications for them and to the vessel.

Crew members needing a passport and/or visa to be in Lithuania territory, must send a copy of their passport and visa page to the organization before departure any other port at least 5 days before arrival in the Port of Klaipėda. Copies to be sent to: valdemaras@seafestival.lt

3.0 Emergency Procedures in Port and Security

At sea. The safety inside the port waters and approaches is responsibility of the Vessel Traffic Service that permanently operates on VHF channel 16 ("Klaipėda radio-5", Phone: +370 46 49 96 91).

In port. In the city, port or at the sea, all safety and security emergencies must be reported immediately to the phone number 112 (Emergency response Centre), who coordinates police, firemen, ambulance, MRCC etc. The 112 attends in English and other languages. 112 should be known by every crew member.

Security issues that are not considered emergency will be reported to the host port through the LO.

3. BERTHING

3.1 Special Berthing Instructions

For berthing operations in the river Dange or to communicate with "FOLLOW ME" RIB's use VHF channel 11.

No fenders and gangways are available: vessels are expected to provide their own fenders and safe means of access to the shore

8. LIAISON SYSTEM

8.1 Liaison System (Explanation of system)

The Liaison System is an important and integrated part of the Support System intended to ensure a smooth and trouble-free stay in the sea port of Klaipėda. Operation of the Liaison System is based on volunteers.

Klaipėda has assigned Liaison Officers (LO) to each vessel within "The Tall Ships Races 2021". Your vessel will be met by a designated LO upon arrival in the port of Klaipėda. Your designated LO will meet your vessel on the 27 of June. Some vessels will arrive earlier and will be met if the LO is available. If you arrive late at night, you will be met the next morning.

The LO we will provide you with essential information, much of which is contained within this manual, and will keep you up-to-date with any revised or new material throughout your stay in Klaipėda.

Your LO will be happy to assist you with any queries you may have and to help you with various arrangements that will be required during your stay – see the details there of in this manual and in the crew manual.

The LO's aim is to assure you and your crew enjoy your visit to Klaipėda. They will advise you of full details of the social events organised for captains and crews.

To ensure the maximum assistance, we expect your LO to spend as much time with your ship and crew as possible.

The LOs can also be contacted at the Liaison Centre (see the map). The Liaison Centre will be open every day from 8.00 to 23.00.

In special cases, the CLO can be contacted directly.

Electricity is available free of charge on most quaysides, although large A class ships will be encouraged to use their own generators.

9.4 Waste

Containers will be made available at various strategic points for household waste. The containers will be emptied every day. Ships should use their own garbage sacks for garbage. Waste sorting is not required. Waste sacks are to be brought to waste containers on the quay by crew members.

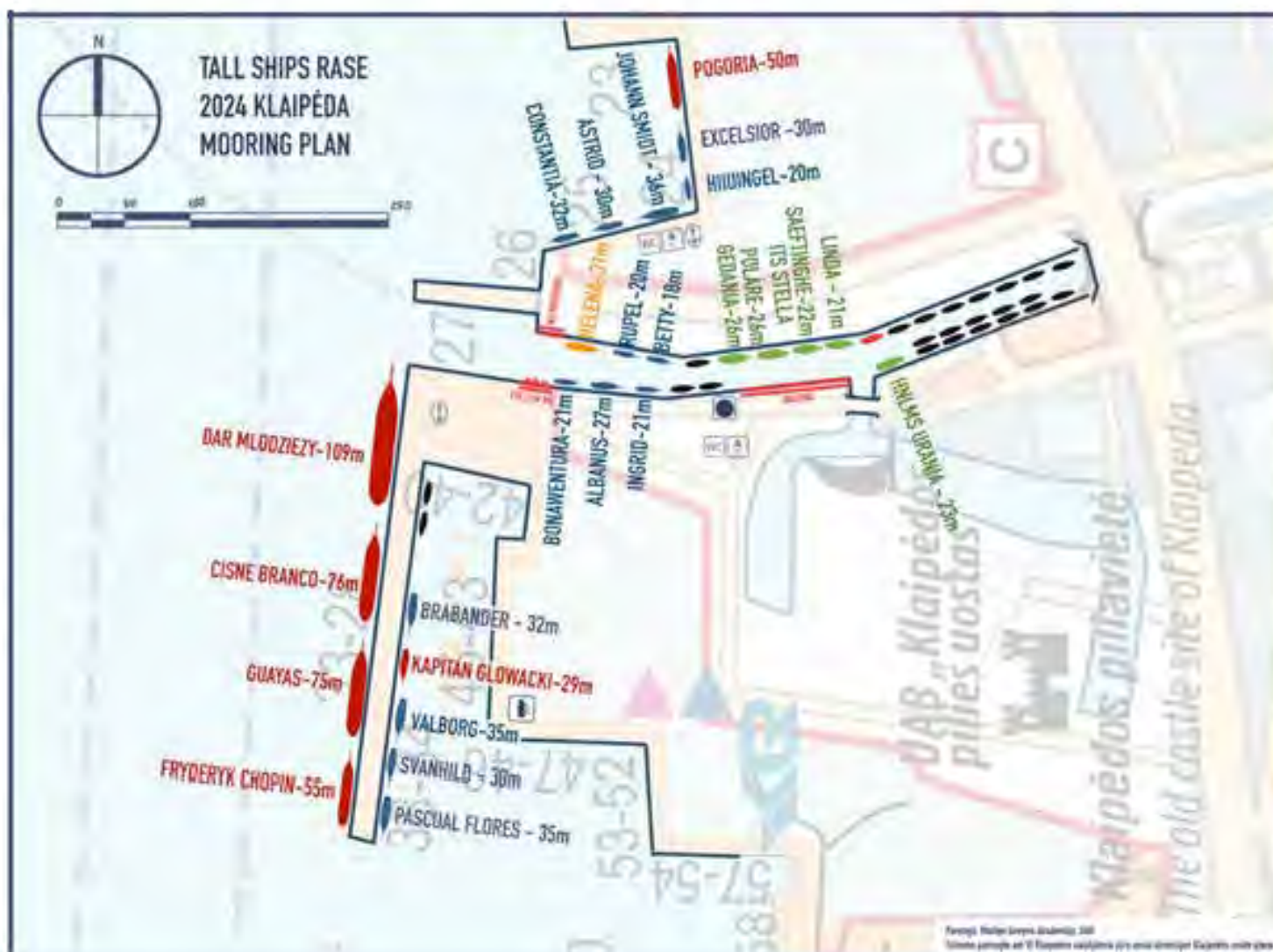
