2.4 PROCEDURES

General instructions

Masters must comply with the Harbour Master's Office instructions and follow the regulations mentioned in the Port web site <https://www.havre-port.com/> which details the useful information for the ship's stay in the port of Le Havre.

The main declarations:

ETA - 48 H: Call request
ETA - 24 H: Inwards declaration
ETA - 12 H: Request for pilot
ETA - 3 H: Confirmation of ETA
Special conditions: Pilotage - Linesmen and Towage

Information on passing the Quinette lock: the gates are open from about 2 hours before up to 15 minutes after high tide; alternative manoeuvring of the upstream and downstream bridges allow passage of ships less than 209 meters long.

2.5 PILOTS

Pilotage is compulsory for vessels over 70 meters LOA, or with more than 50 passengers, or using tug services.

Service of pilots is free of charge for arrival, one shifting if necessary, and departure only.

It is available for any vessel requesting it.

Duty free purchases

Duty free purchases concern products or goods that crew and passengers on the ship can use on arriving or on leaving. It is for personal use or consumption. Military vessels and merchant ships are the only ships available to benefit of non duty free purchases. (They own a blue pad of Frenchifying)

Crew list have to be noticed in the port single windows <https://www.havre-port.com/> by ships organization or representatives for ships of more 45 meters LOA. Other ships keep crew list on board ready in case of police check.

Crew list (officers, crew members, trainees, customers...) **must be sent to the organization** in an Excel file with the following items (last name/date of birth/first name) to the e-mail addresses two days before arrival in Le Havre: dipn76-paf-spaftp@interieur.gouv.fr and gerard.vastra@lesgrandesvoilesduhavre.fr (Chief Liaison Officer)

Every passport **opened at the right page (name + photo)** must be available for control by the Immigration Authorities when they come on board.

2.8 SECURITY

Vessels requiring ISPS arrangements must inform the Harbour Master's Office as soon as possible.

Ships of more than 45 meters LOA have to notice the preliminary security declaration via the community system <https://www.havre-port.com/>

Captains are advised to check the access at anytime.

3. BERTHING

3.1 SPECIAL BERTHING INSTRUCTIONS

Piloted ships have to use linesmen to pass Quinette lock for berthing and leaving.
Small ships may be help by the organization if necessary to pass Quinette lock for berthing and leaving.
If ships require assistance contact VHF channel 12 the Havre Port 2 hours before arrival.

Linesmen :

Mooring service can be operated by crewmembers, linesmen, Normandy Sailing League operators and **nobody else**.
If required, the service of linesmen is free of charge on arrival, one shifting if necessary, and departure, including the assistance of a launch.

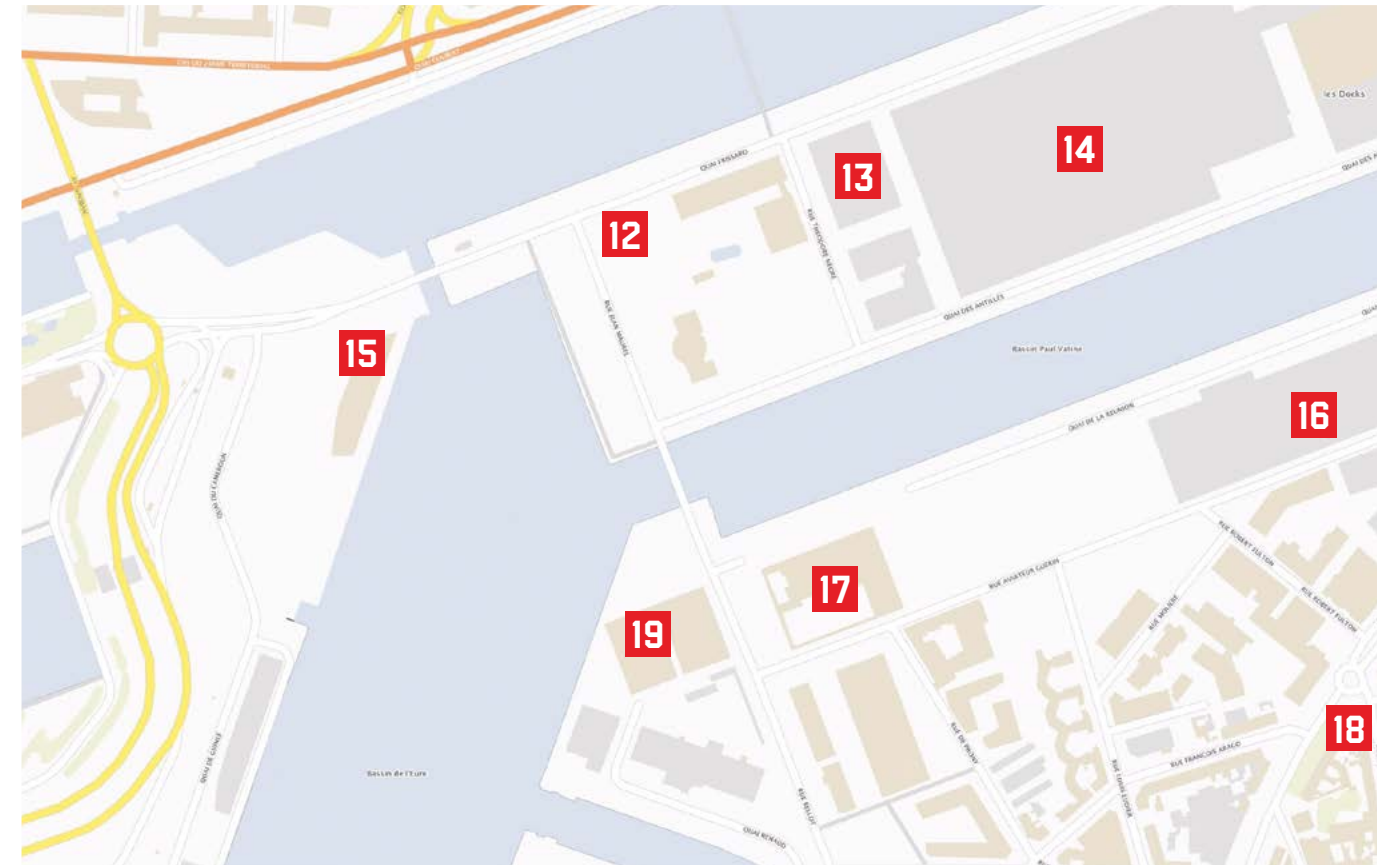

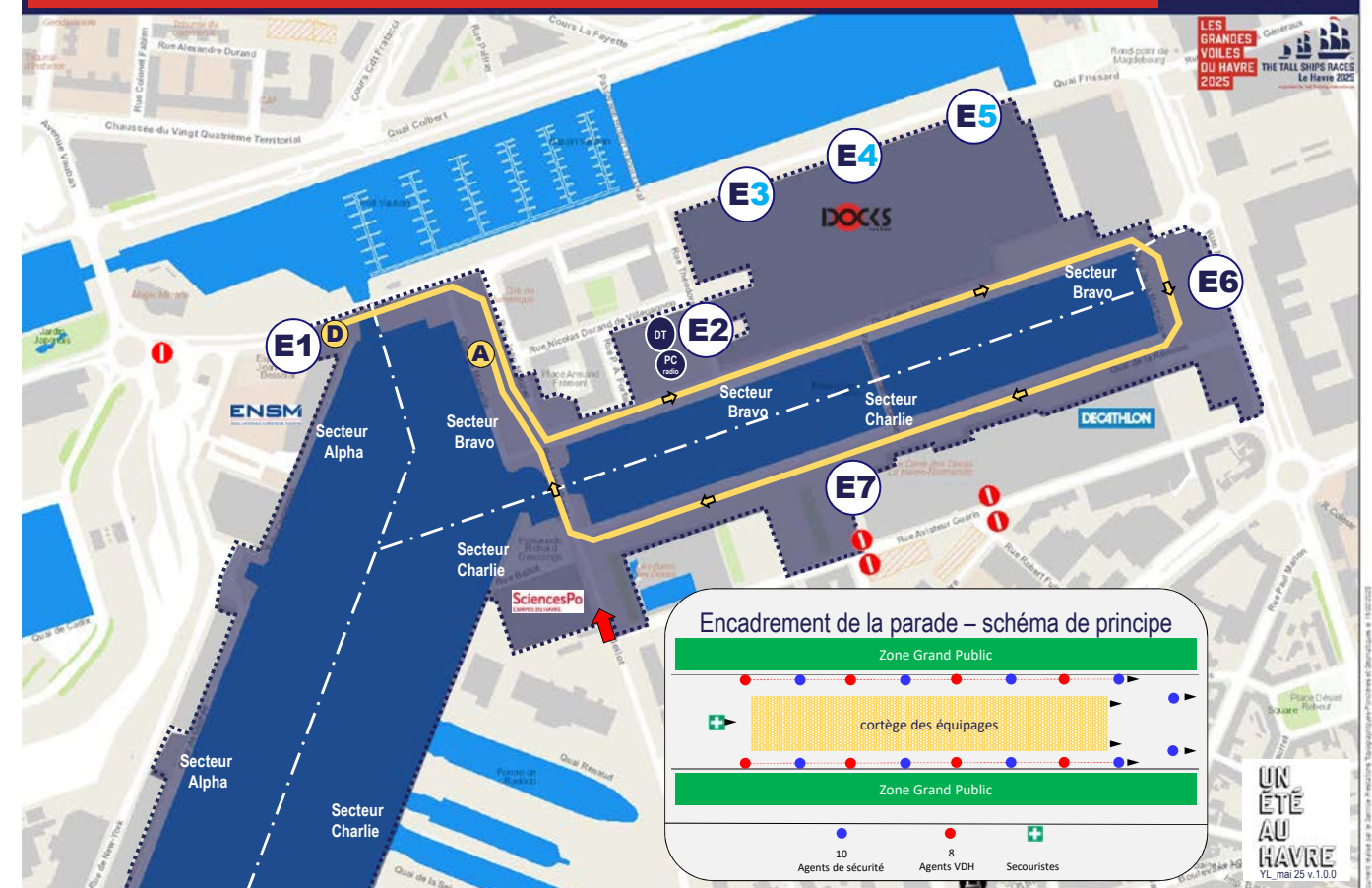

Visits

Perret Historic show flat

This show flat allows you to discover the fittings proposed by the Perret workshop to rehouse the inhabitants: double exposure, sunlight at all time. The furniture chosen is in keeping with the fittings of show flats introduced during the post-war reconstruction period that were meant for the inhabitants of Le Havre victim of the war. The mass-produced furniture - at the origin of design- deserves to be re-discovered for its rational quality and its perfect finish. The origin of the "Trente Glorieuses" (the thirty-year boom period after WW2) is being told through every-day things: fridge, gas cooker, pressure cooker but also record player, typewriter, clothes or newspapers bring the visitor back in time, at the time at the origin of the lifestyle we know nowadays.

The Beach

A two kilometres long sand & pebbles beach between le Havre and Sainte-Adresse situated only 500 metres from the city centre. The fitted out beach promenade is surrounded by an aquatic garden and playgrounds. Seasonal restaurants with terraces turned towards the sea offer different types of cuisine. The beach is watched by lifeguards in summer. Special facilities allow disabled people to access the entire site which was granted the "Tourism & Handicap" label. Famous fun-board spot in Sainte-Adresse

Notre Dame Cathedral

Shortly after the city of Le Havre was founded, in 1522, a chapel of wood and thatch was built along the main street of the city, rue Saint-Michel which became rue de Paris later. It was reinforced and a church tower was added in the 16th century. It was restored in the 19th century after the religious wars and the French Revolution. Damaged by the bombings in September 1944, the restoration work was over in 1974 at the time when the parish church became the cathedral of the diocese.

MUMA – André Malraux Museum (Modern Art)

Overlooking the sea, the Museum is an exceptional building of glass and steel. The pieces of classical and baroque art prove the will of the museum to reflect major periods in the history of European art, the collection's particularity is the importance granted to Impressionism. With three hundred Boudin paintings, some Monet, Gauguin, Renoir, Pissarro... the museum shelters the largest collection in France outside Paris revolving around Impressionism. Fauvism is also very present with pieces by Van Dongen, Marquet, Camoin, Dufy and Friesz. The museum is also a library, a shop, a café and art workshops for children and adults.

Saint Joseph Church

A lighthouse at the heart of the city, Saint-Joseph Church is special because of its octagonal lantern-tower reaching a height of 110 metres, joined to the square base of the building, sheltering the nave and the choir. Started in 1951 and completed in 1957, after the death of Auguste Perret, the church stands out as one of the architectural masterpieces of the 20th century. Inside the church, 12.768 pieces of coloured glass, work of Marguerite Huré, light up the concrete.

Dubocage de Bléville Mansion

Exposition "Small sailings"

Before becoming a museum, this private mansion was, during the 18th century, the property of one of Le Havre's great figures: the navigator, privateer, and trader Michel Dubocage de Bléville (1676-1727). He gained fame for participating in a major trading voyage around the Pacific Ocean, passing Cape Horn between 1707 and 1716.

Starting February 8, 2025, in keeping with the maritime theme of the year 2025 and in harmony with the Grandes Voiles du Havre and the Transat Jacques Vabre, some one hundred works from local heritage collections will be displayed in the museum.

These «small sailings», displayed on the ground floor and in two rooms on the first floor, will celebrate the heyday of sailing ships and the city of Le Havre from the 16th to the mid-19th century. Shipbuilding, ship typologies and portraits, maritime activities: fishing, the military, trading, sporting and artistic worlds will be evoked through a selection of graphic works, paintings, models and art objects or curiosities. Unpublished acquisitions, recently restored drawings, old heritage collections will question the image of the sailing ship through its multiple dimensions: functional, aesthetic, artistic, poetic or symbolic.

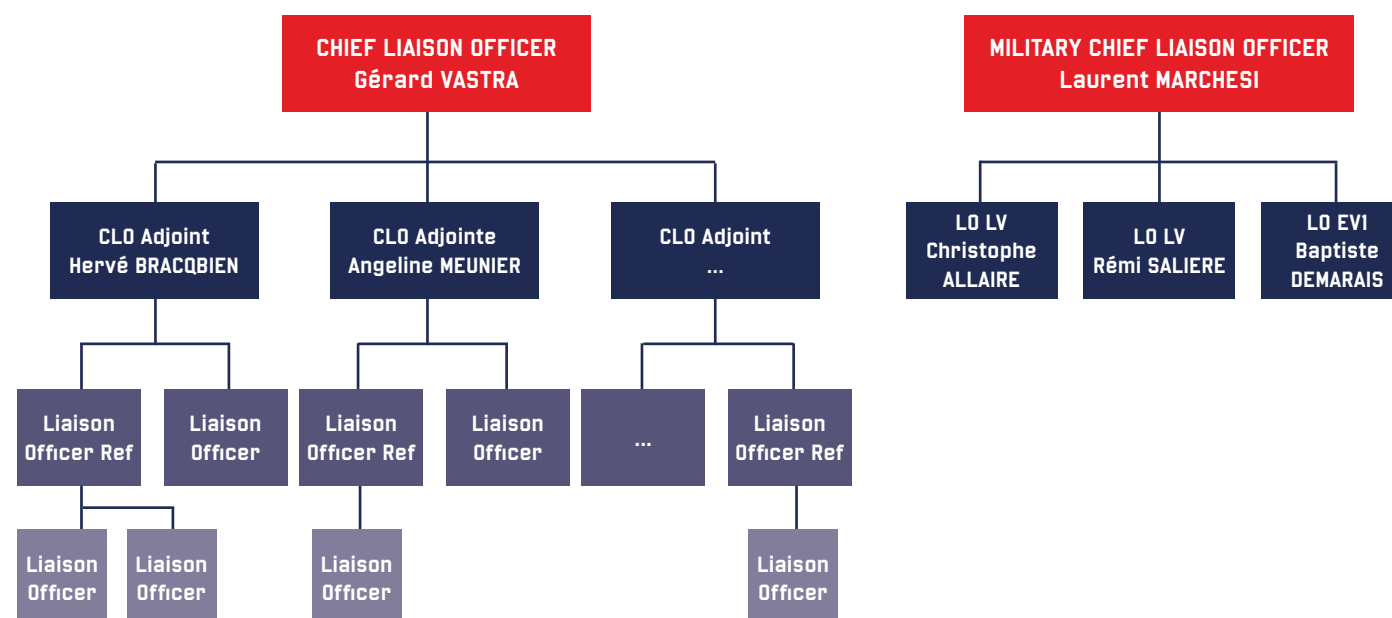

9. SHIP SERVICES

9.1 FUEL

Ships' bunkering and supplies

Ship's bunkering and delivery of heavy equipment by road must be previously declared to the Harbour Master's Office. Same operations are subject to Harbour Master's Office authorization when they are carried out by barge and tanker by road. During the operations, the shipmaster must take any useful measure to guarantee the safety of the service providers working on his account. Any precaution must be taken to avoid or limit the effects of a possible pollution of the water surface or the quays when bunkering.

Le Havre outer Marina gas-oil station, for ships under 20 meters long or 2,00 meters draught (at low tide): gasoline unleaded 98, diesel, 24/24h, available with credit card

Environmental protection

Discharging any solid, liquid or pulverulent substance in port waters, access ways and channels is strictly forbidden. Chimney-sweeping and waste incineration are forbidden in the port. Any water pollution must be immediately dealt with and declared to the Harbour Master's office and the terminal operator. Vessels must use low sulphur-content (0, 1 %) bunkers, in compliance with the valid regulations, during their stay at berth.
