RACING RULES UPDATES

FUNDAMENTAL RULE VII. Environmental Responsibility

Tall Ships Races International Limited strongly encourages all activities which minimise any negative impact and do not significantly harm the environment during their events.

17.2 **Gates** between two positions may be used as marks of the course. A vessel must cross the Gate Line from the direction of the last mark and must record the time when any part of her hull or equipment crosses this line.
Note The Gate Line may be used as the Finish Line (see Rule 19) if the course needs to be shortened.

17.3 **Exclusion Zones** such as Traffic Separation Schemes and other restricted areas may be published as marks of the course. These areas should not be entered unless there are safety concerns, which should be recorded on the Race Declaration (Rule 3.3)

3.3 Declarations

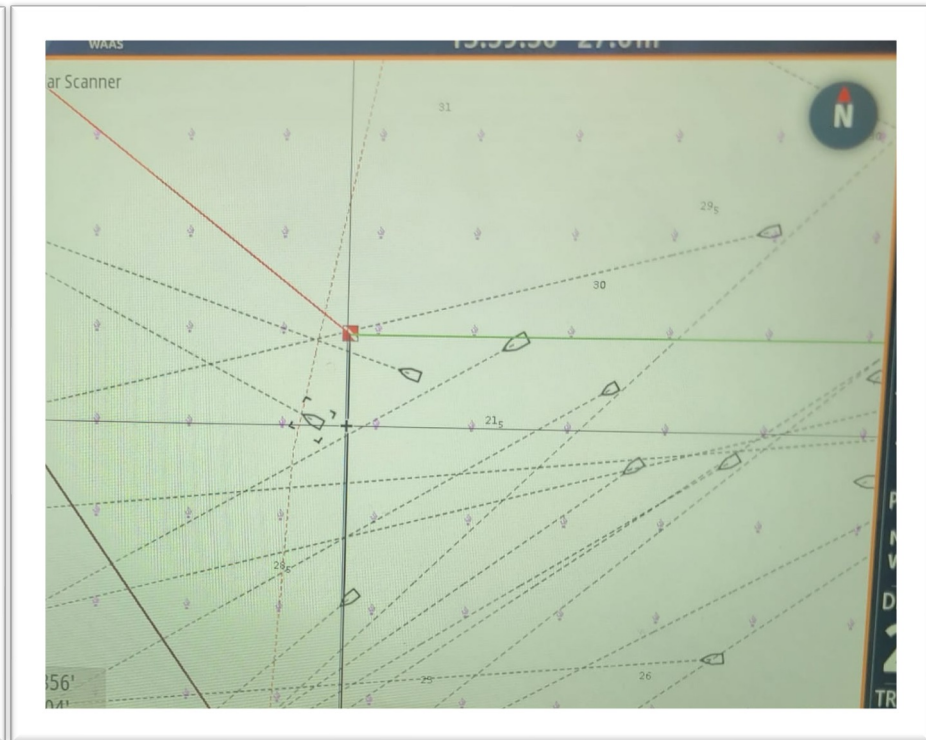
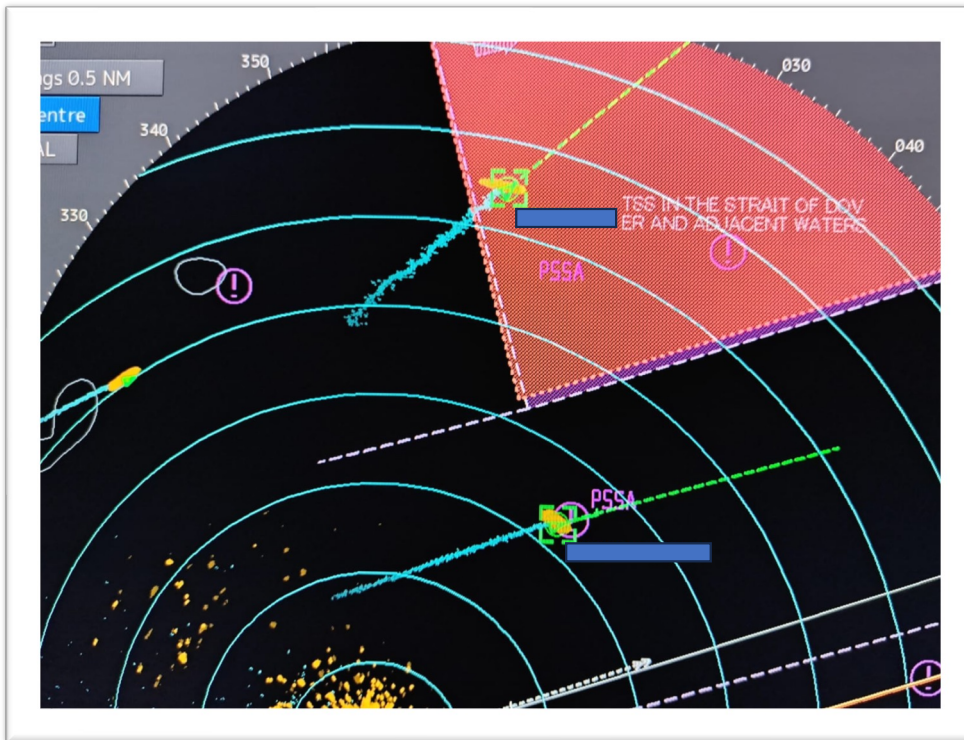
3.3.1 A completed Race Declaration shall be completed on the Gateway as soon as the vessel berths at the Finish Port. Failure to do so will result in the vessel receiving a Standard Time Penalty (see Rule 15.2) or being treated as having failed to complete the course.

3.3.2 Any contravention, however trivial, of any of these Racing Rules, the Sailing and Communication Instructions or any contravention of the COLREGS must be recorded on the Race Declaration.

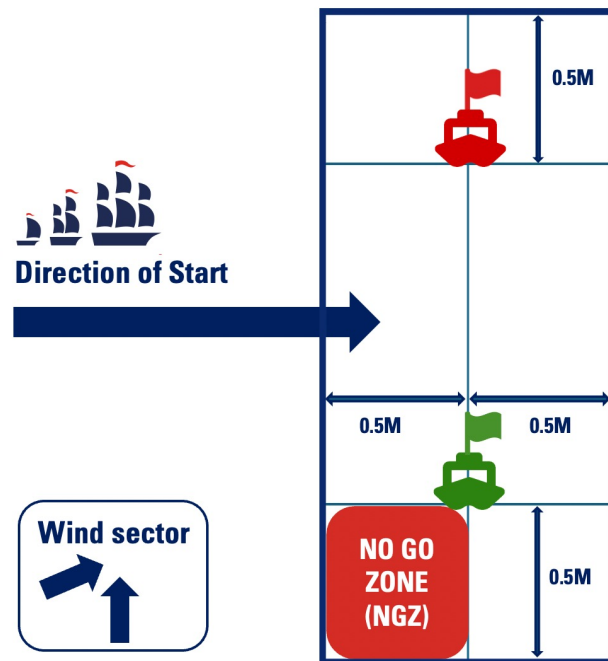

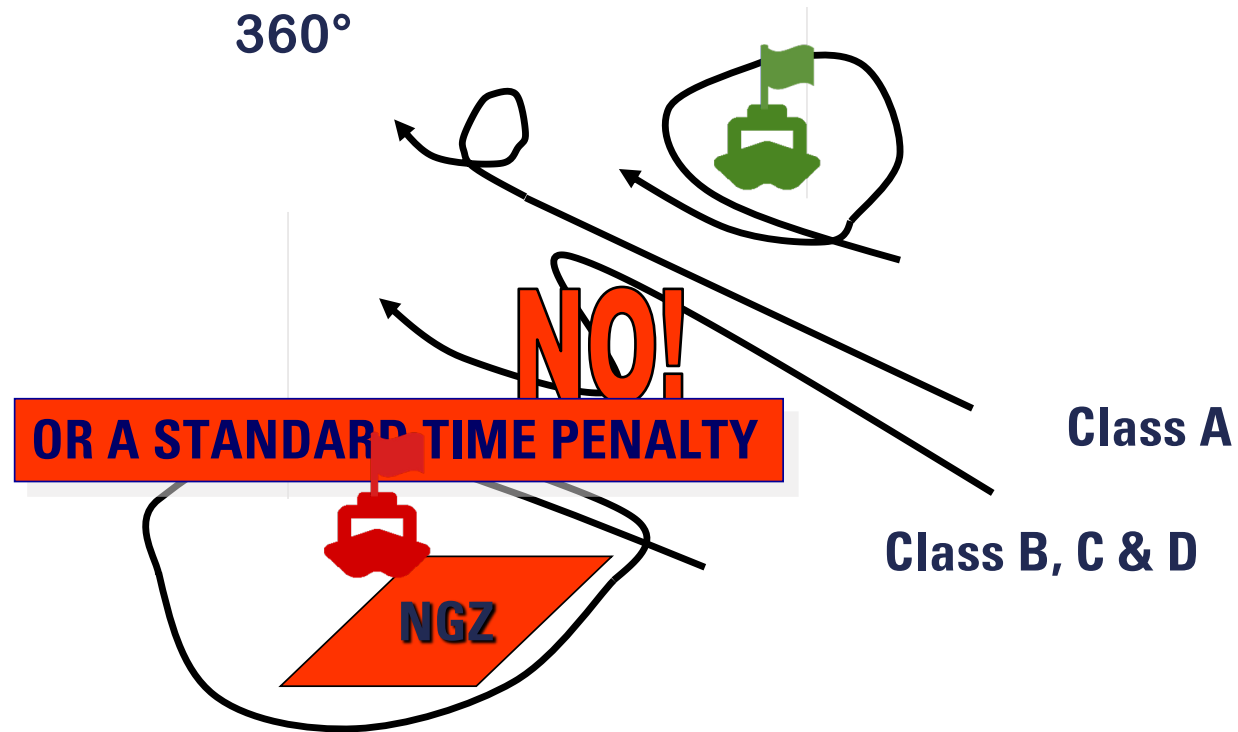

- ENGINE MUST NOT BE USED LESS THAN 20 MINS BEFORE THE START (UNLESS MORE THAN 1NM FROM THE START LINE)

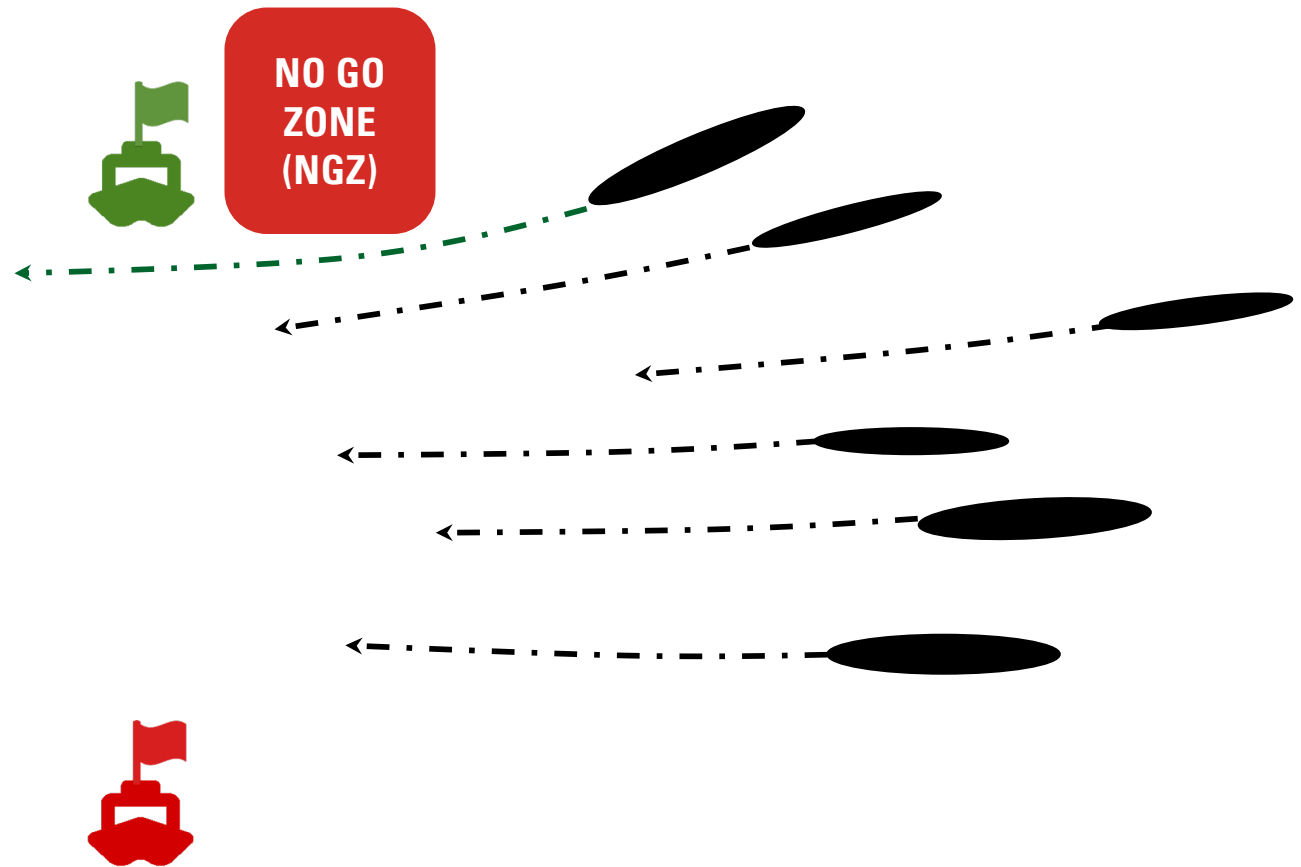

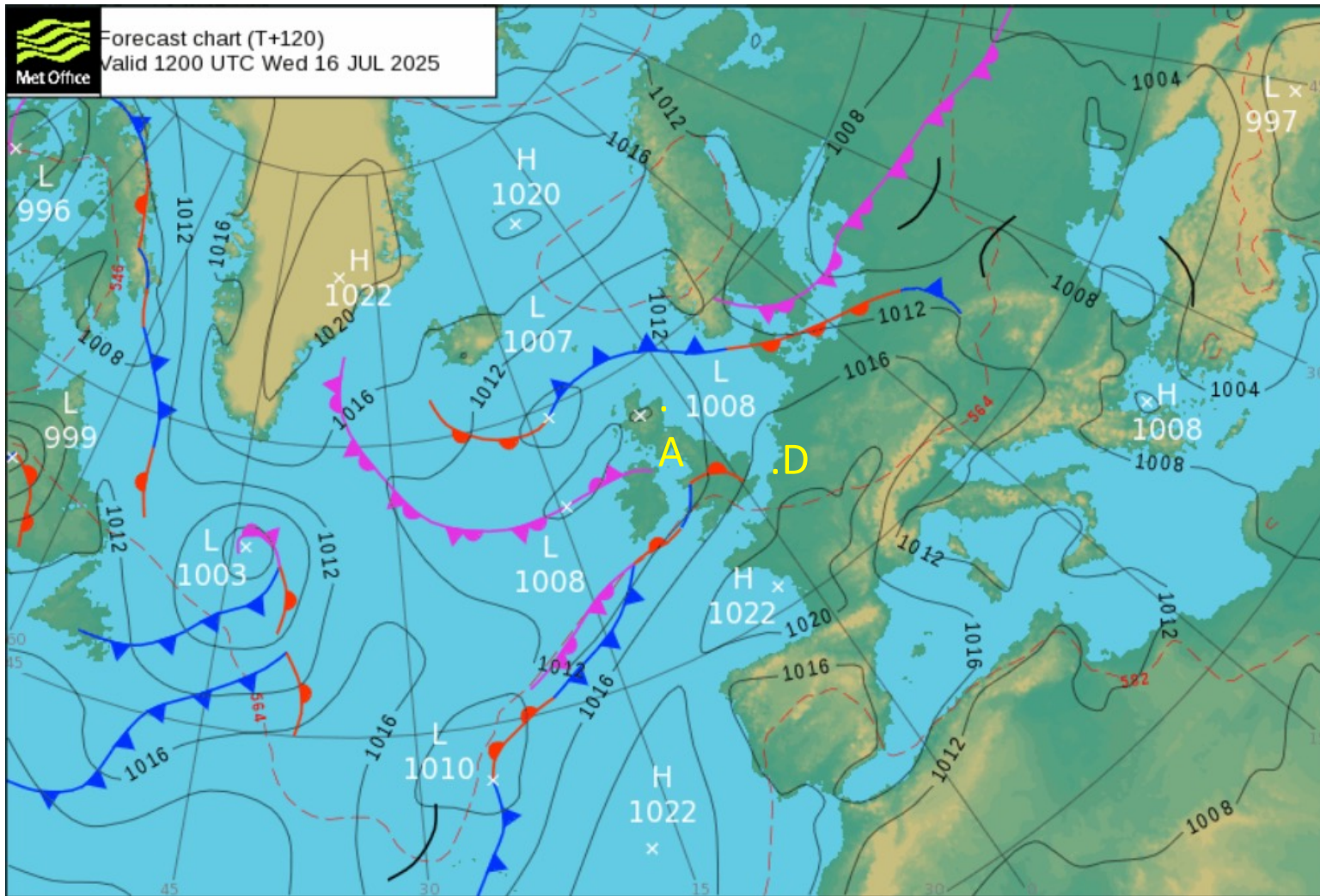
Forecast chart (T+60)

FORECAST OVERVIEW – CURRENT WATCH POINTS

- WINDS: During Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday morning Mean ≥ 20 kt to ≤ 25 kt and gusts ≥ 25 kt to ≤ 35 kt – mainly in southern and central North Sea
- WINDS: During Thursday, Friday and Saturday Light mean ≤ 5 kt and variable at times with sea breezes by day and land breezes by night – especially close to shore
- WEATHER: During Sunday and Monday, few showers around, possibly thundery
- VISIBILITY: Potential for areas of mist and fog, especially in and around the weather fronts crossing the North Sea during Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday

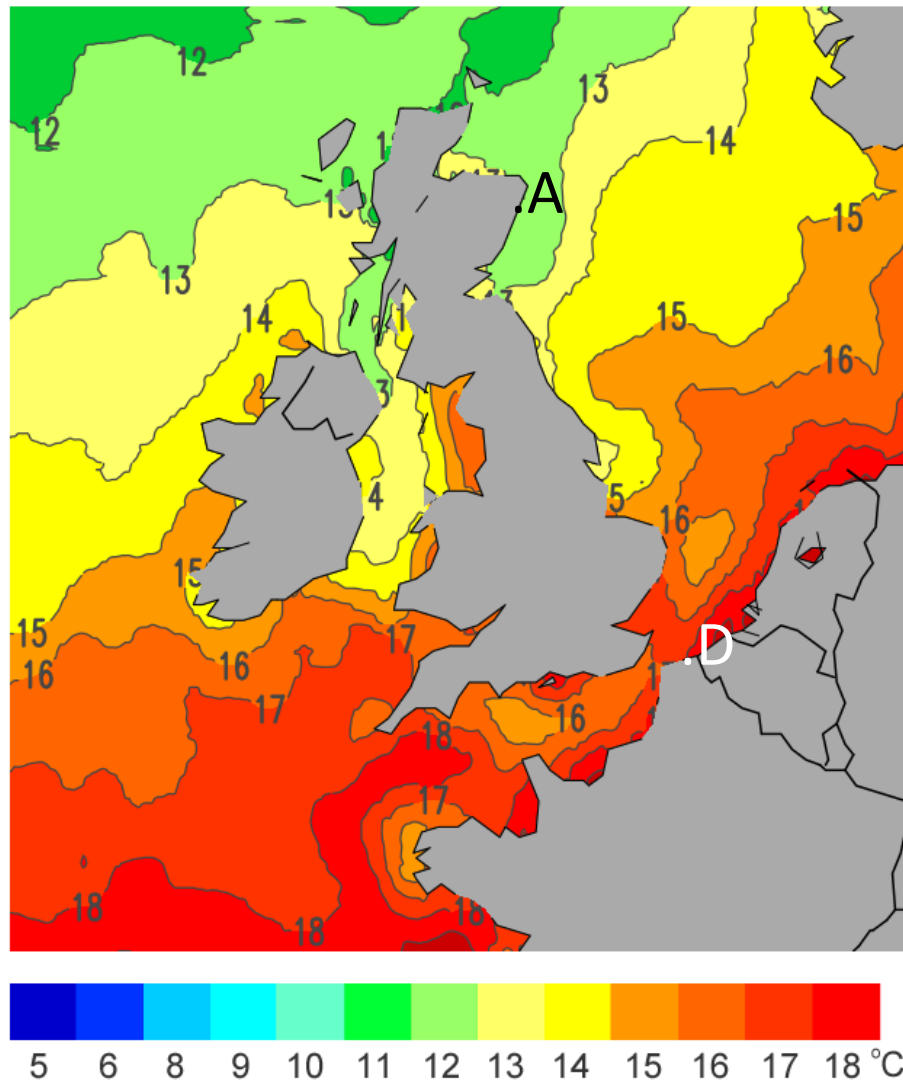

When the dewpoint* temperature is *ABOVE* these (SST) – potential for mist/fog to form over the sea – as the air is cooled to the SST.

Mostly expected in and around the weather fronts on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday

*Dewpoint - the temperature to which air must be cooled for water vapour to condense into liquid water, forming mist/fog

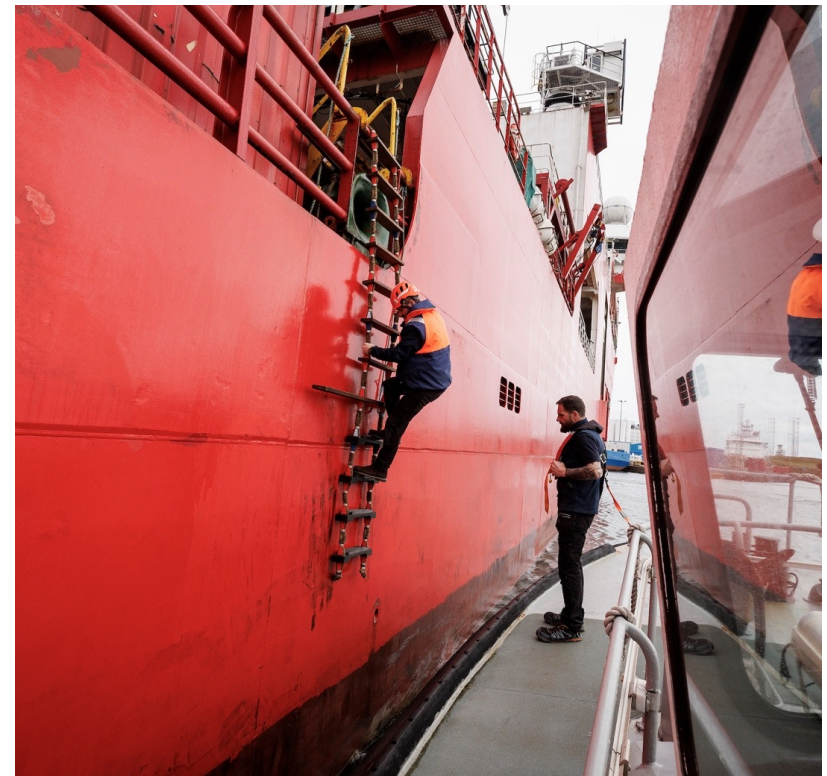
Pilotage & Towage

Pilotage:

- Compulsory for all vessels, except:
 - Under 60m in length
 - 60-74.99m with operational bow thruster
 - Berth-to-berth movements with VTS permission
- Free pilotage provided for Tall Ships
- Pilot boards approx 1nm from Fairway Buoy (POB confirmed via VTS)

Towage:

- Provided by Targe Towing Ltd
- Tug(s) to be requested by the vessel and arranged by the Port.
- Provide Pilot on Board (POB) time and departure time to Targe

- Victoria Dock
 - Waterloo Quay
 - Regent Quay
 - Upper Dock

Berthing Arrangements:

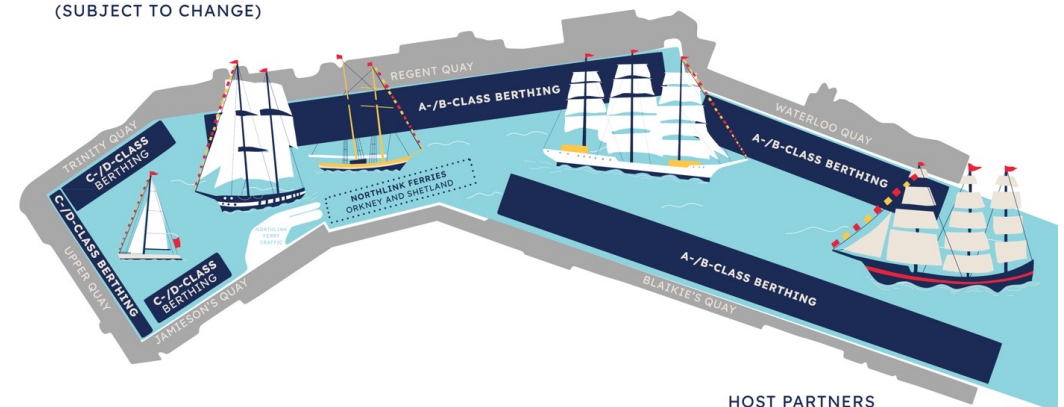

- **All deliveries** must be directed to the Delivery yard - address in the **Captain's manual, section 8.4**.
- Vehicles will only be allowed on Quayside between 2300 hrs and 0730 hrs.
- Tell your SLO you expect a delivery ASAP, and they can confirm details with the Yard.
- Deliveries can be held at delivery yard in containers and collected **in person** from the yard during public opening hours.
- Trolleys will be available from the Event centre if required.

Safety, Security & Emergencies

Vessel Traffic Services (VTS):

- All movements controlled by Aberdeen VTS
- Maintain continuous watch on VHF Channel 12 & 16

Emergency Contact:

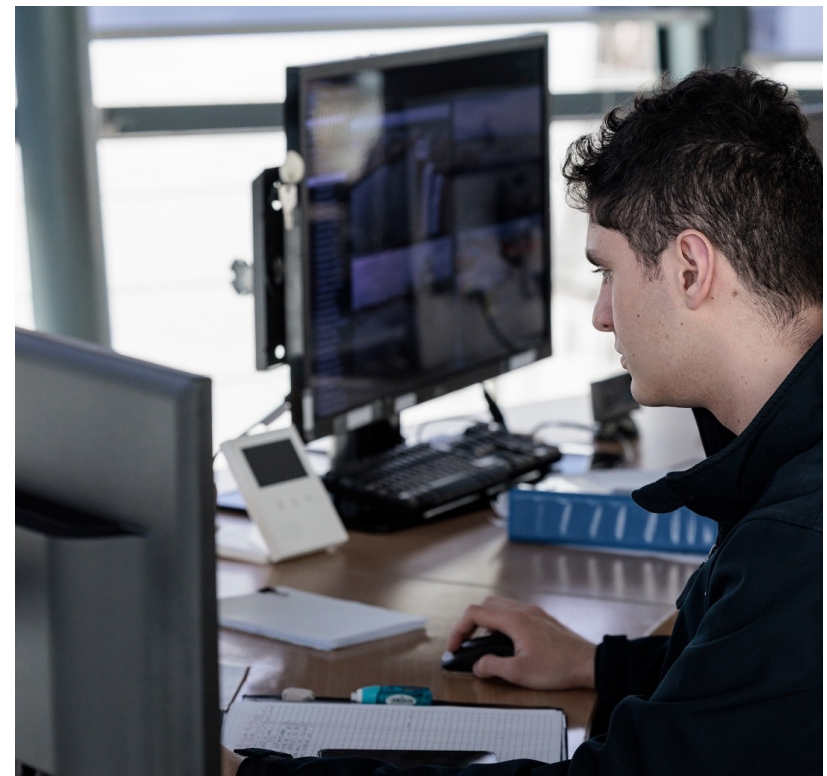
- In case of onboard emergency, call Aberdeen Coastguard on VHF 16 or Aberdeen VTS on VHF 12
- Port of Aberdeen follows standard emergency response protocols.

ISPS & Security:

- Port is ISPS compliant
- SOLAS vessels (300 GT+) must submit CERS Workbook 24h before arrival
 - Includes ETA, last 10 port calls, security level
 - Submit via agent or directly to VTS

Access:

- Vessels are responsible for their own security and access control
- Ensure gangways are safe and comply with guidance (e.g. max 5m onto quay, avoid blocking pedestrian flow)
