## 2.4 CALL SIGNS

The call sign is 'Harlingen Port'.

## 2.5 PROCEDURES

All vessels report to Brandaris Traffic on VHF CH 2 when passing ZS Racon buoy entering the Stortemelk fairway. Brandaris Traffic will guide you to the pilot station or anchorage. Vessel Traffic Service is available between ZS Racon buoy and buoy BS 2.

There are frequent ferry services between Harlingen and the islands Terschelling and Vlieland, both with conventional ferries and fast ferries; the latter carry the additional yellow flashing lights. Arrivals/Departures in Harlingen (Summer Time): FR between 8:00 and 22:30, SAT between 8:00 and 22:15, SUN between 8:30 and 20:30, MON between 7:30 and 21:00

Never enter or leave Harlingen Harbour without listening and reporting to Harbour control: VHF 11. One may encounter dredgers, cargo ships, ferries and yachts.

The official languages for communication between vessels and the traffic centre are English and Dutch. Only if safety is at risk other languages may be used.

The Waddensee is part of the UNESCO World Heritage. Currently, the water in

the Port of Harlingen is so clean, that it meets the International Requirements for bathing water. Therefore, we ask you to be so kind to help us to take good care of our clean water in the harbour. Thank you in advance!

### Parade of Sail (Sail-In and out)

For Information about the Sail In and Sail Out Parade "schedule" see appendix attached.

Ships which participate in the parade of sail will be assigned a mooring location on the Vlierede or in the Westmeep by VC (VC = Verkeers Centrale = Traffic Centre) Brandaris, after consultation with the pilot and the captain. In the assignment of the moorings one will take into account the ship's position in the Sail-In Parade; thus crossing courses can be avoided while lining up for the parade. When the ship is safely moored anchor watch is required and one should be standby at VHF channel 2. Ships are free to stay out at sea and to follow the Sail-In Parade.

### 2.6 PILOTS

Pilots for Harlingen Port are available on request for all ships and compulsory

for all ships over 75/-/6 (L/B/D). Contact the Pilot Coordination Centre North at least 6 hours before ETA at Vlieree SM7 – ZS16.

Pilots are free of charge for those ships that request them, once for entering and once for leaving.

VHF CH 19

The vessel has to proceed to the ZS / RACON (T) BUOY which lies outside in the North sea in the entrance-fairway Zuider Stortemelk between the islands of Terschelling and Vlieland.

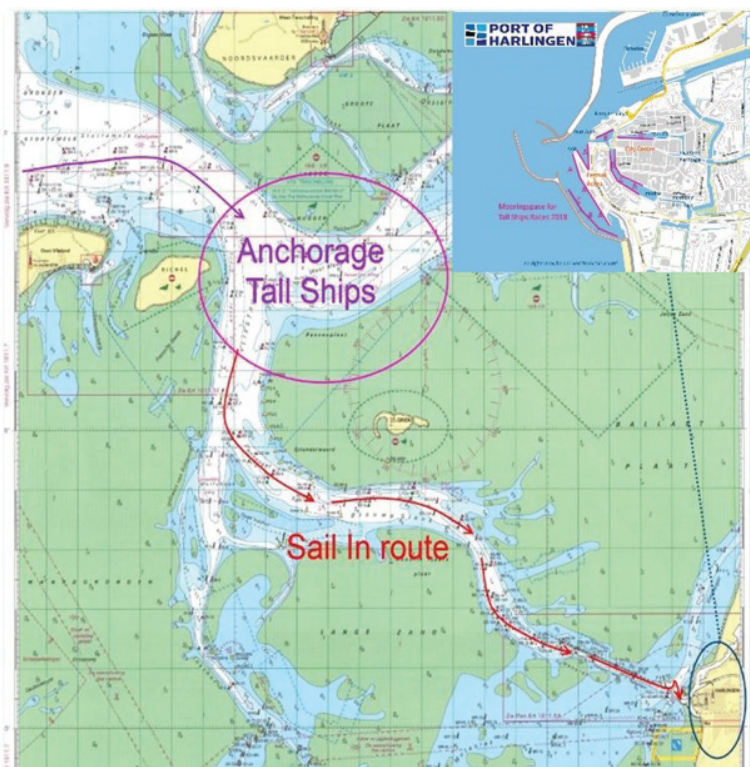
Pilot can be obtained at the ZS / RACON (T) BUOY or at the Vlierede at SM7 – ZS16 BUOY.

You need to order the pilot approx. 12 hrs. prior arrival ZS / RACON (T) BUOY or at SM7 – ZS16 BUOY to Harlingen pilot station stating:

- Ship's name
  - Call sign
  - Draft
  - LOA
  - GT
  - Latest Port of Call
  - Port of Destination or AS SOON AS IN RANGE on VHF channel 2 when in range of traffic centre Brandaris.
- Vessel to repeat her ETA 6 and 2 hours prior to arrival pilot-buoy outside or inside on VHF channel 19 to pilot station Harlingen or to pilot-boat 45 minutes before pilot-boarding on channel 2.

At any time vessel can communicate via coastguard BRANDARIS on VHF channels 2 – 4– 5 or call on SAR-67 calling for coastguard BRANDARIS.

## **2.7 TUGS**

Tugs are available at all times with 2 hours' notice. If needed a small 'push-me' boat is also available. Tugs are free of charge to those ships that request them. One free assistance in and one out of the port.

## **2.8 CUSTOMS/IMMIGRATIONS**

During the period that the vessel is ashore, no (non) duty paid goods may be taken out of stock for personal use or for festivities on board or on shore. Should you want to use excise goods that have been declared before entering the port, these goods will have to be released into free circulation. Release into free circulation means that all taxes and customs duties need to be fulfilled before the goods can be taken from stock.

The A-class ships will be checked by the shipping agents in a regular manner by means of the pre-arrival set. For the other ships we have agreed that they are exempt from customs clearance, on the condition that they do not have any duty-free goods (drinks/cigarettes) on board. In that case they will have to clear through

When entering or leaving harbours in the Netherlands a captain will be confronted with border control (immigration; the name of this unit is Koninklijke Marechaussee). Officers of the unit will check the data of crew and passengers. Checks of the crew and passengers present on board may be either physical and/or administrative.

A physical control will take place on board of the ship. For this check you are

supposed to have the correct papers and documents at hand. Persons mentioned on the lists of crew members and passengers should be available for a possible personal check.

Documents sent per E-mail will be inspected in the administrative check. Digitally sending both crew and passenger lists leads to a swift and efficient handling of all papers.

Pre arrival sets for class A ships (including Dos forms) will be sent by ships's agents "Nesta Shipping" or "Kuhlman Repko" and need to be returned by email to sender at least 24 hours prior to arrival in Harlingen. For all other nautical matters relating to your visit to Harlingen, you may send an email to [henk@harlingensail.com](mailto:henk@harlingensail.com).

Crew list set for B-C\_D classs ships intended for immigration office "Koninklijke Marechaussee" will be sent by [henk@harlingensail.com](mailto:henk@harlingensail.com) and need to be returned by email to sender at least 24 hours prior to arrival at Harlingen.

## **2.9 SECURITY**

ISPS security arrangements are content of the pre arrival set. The Dutch law stipulates that any form of crime or noncompliance with Dutch laws and/or legislation, committed ashore or on board of vessels, other than navy ships, within the Dutch territorial waters will be tried by a Dutch court.

The environmental rules will be monitored by Harlingen Seaport, the Wetterskip and the Water Police.

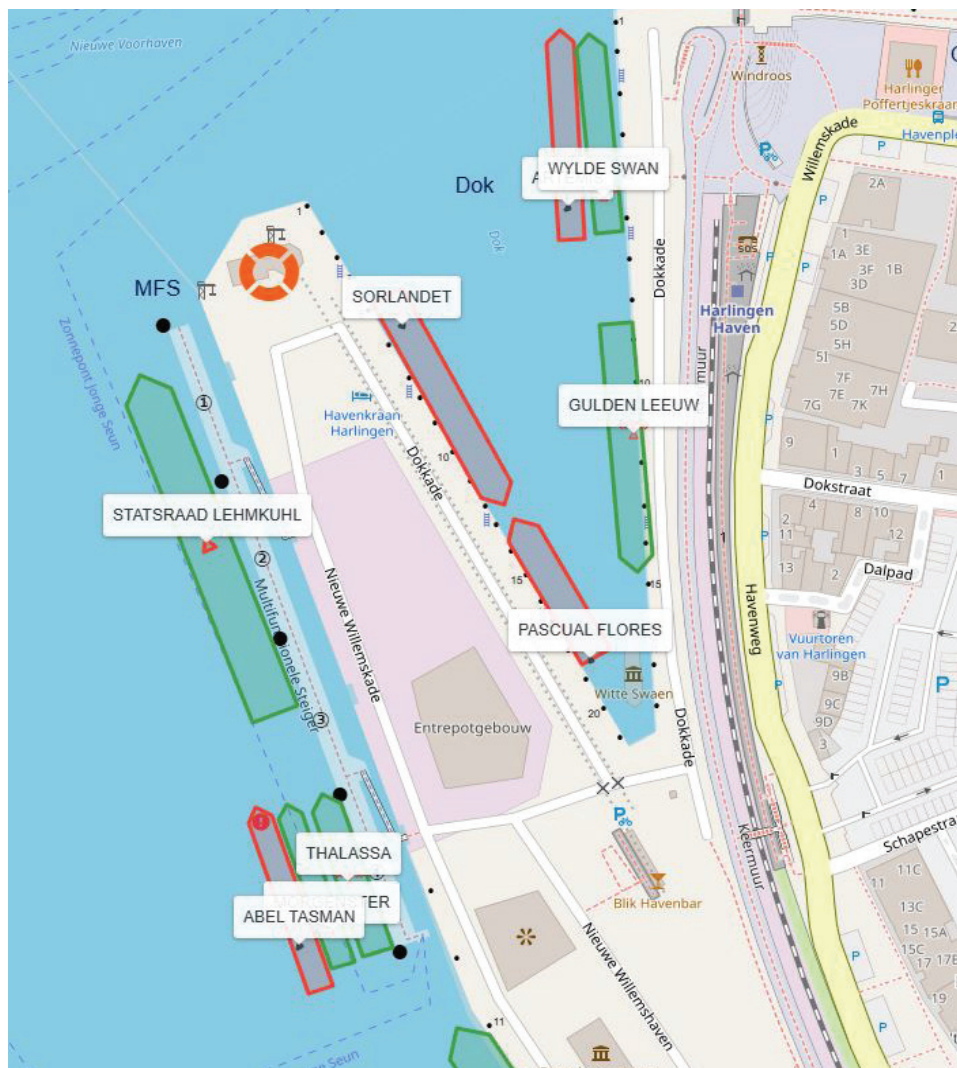

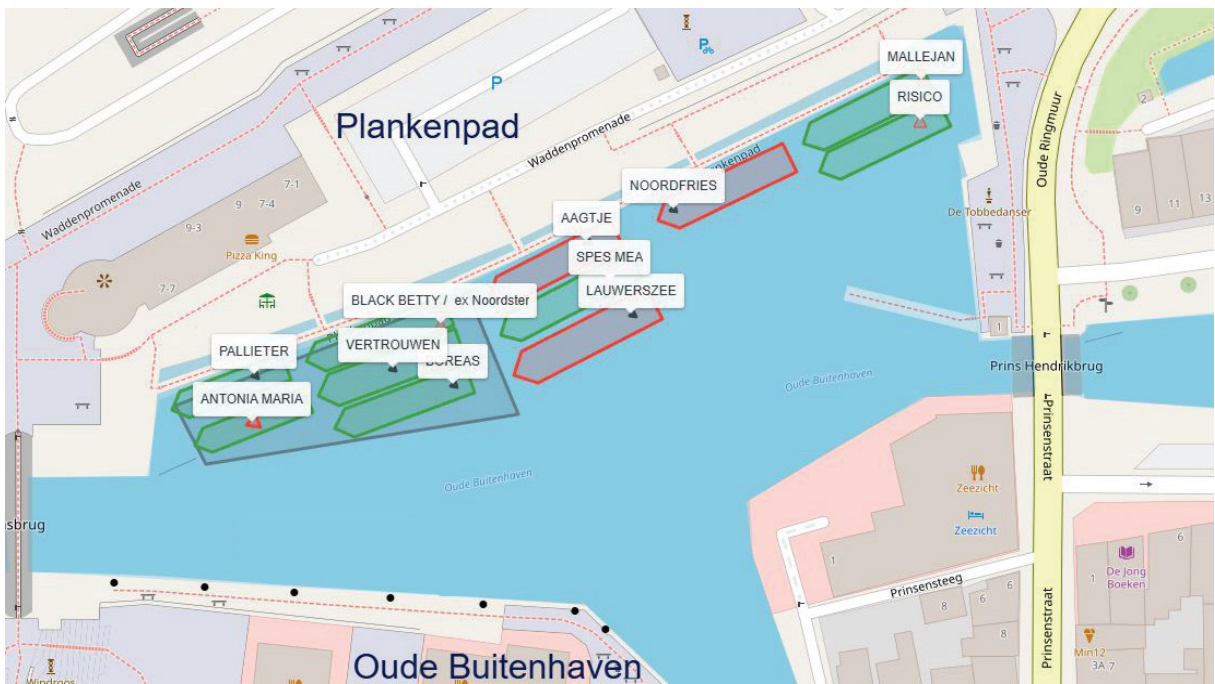
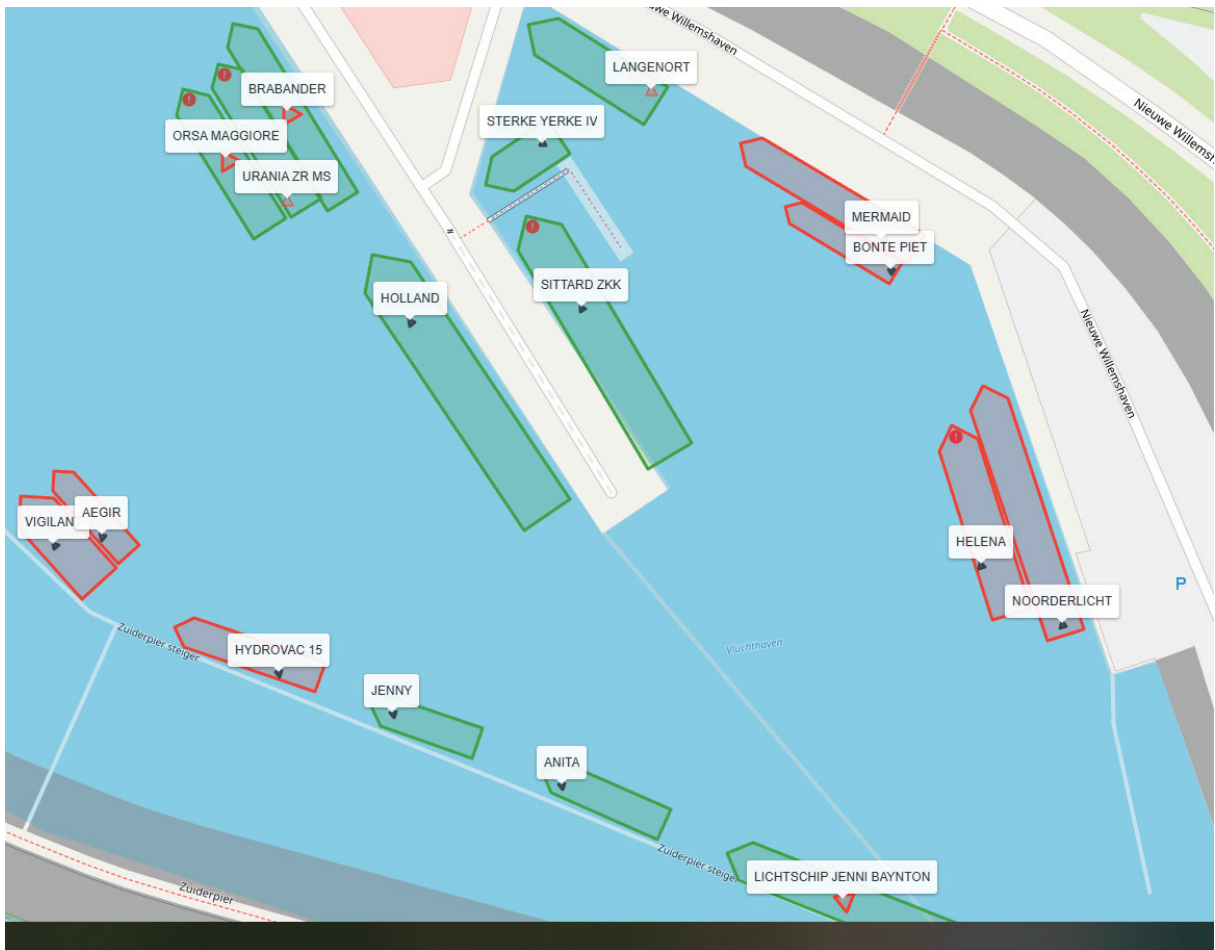
Non participating ships on the parade of sail have to be in port before 11.00 AM on Friday July 3rd

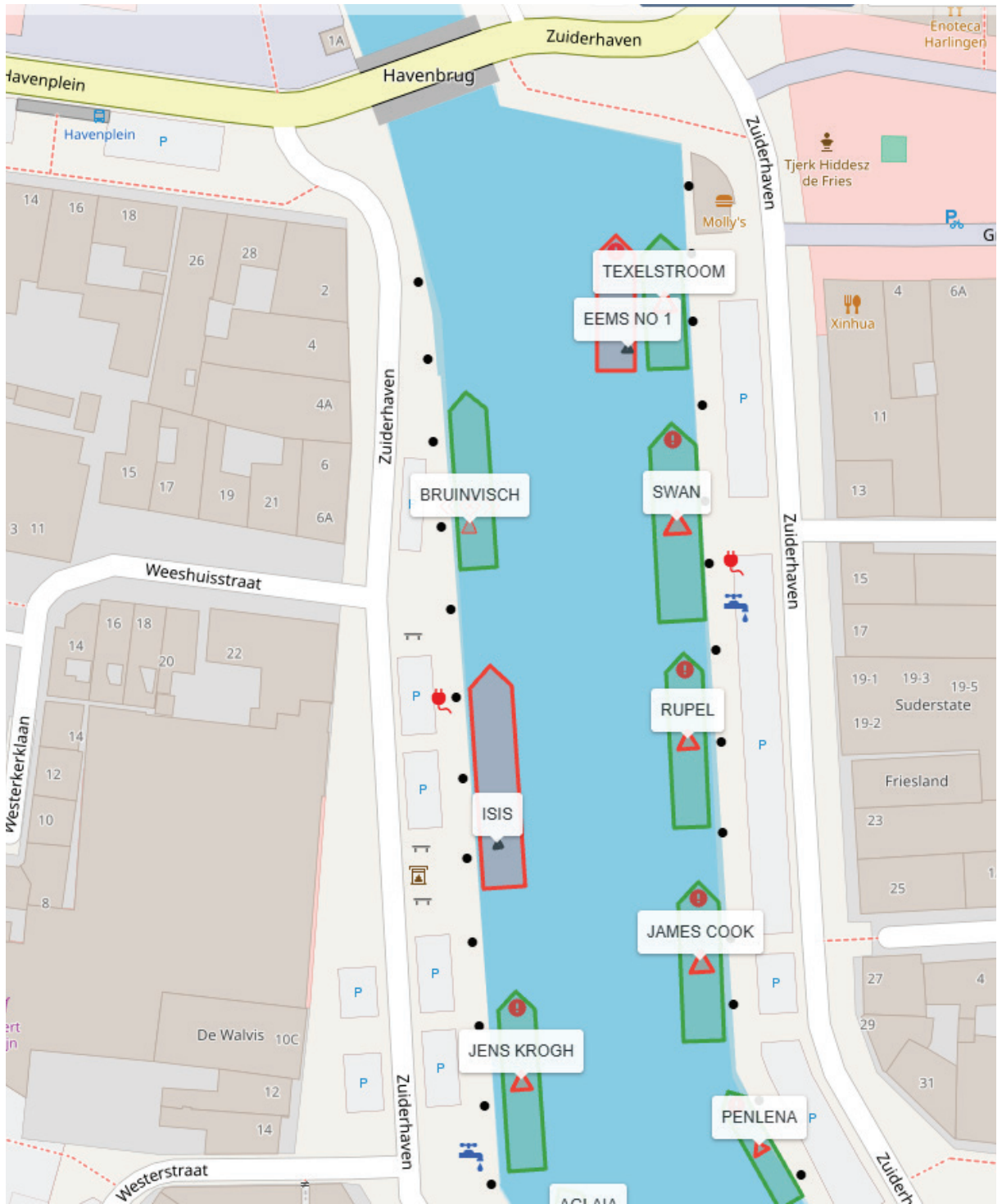

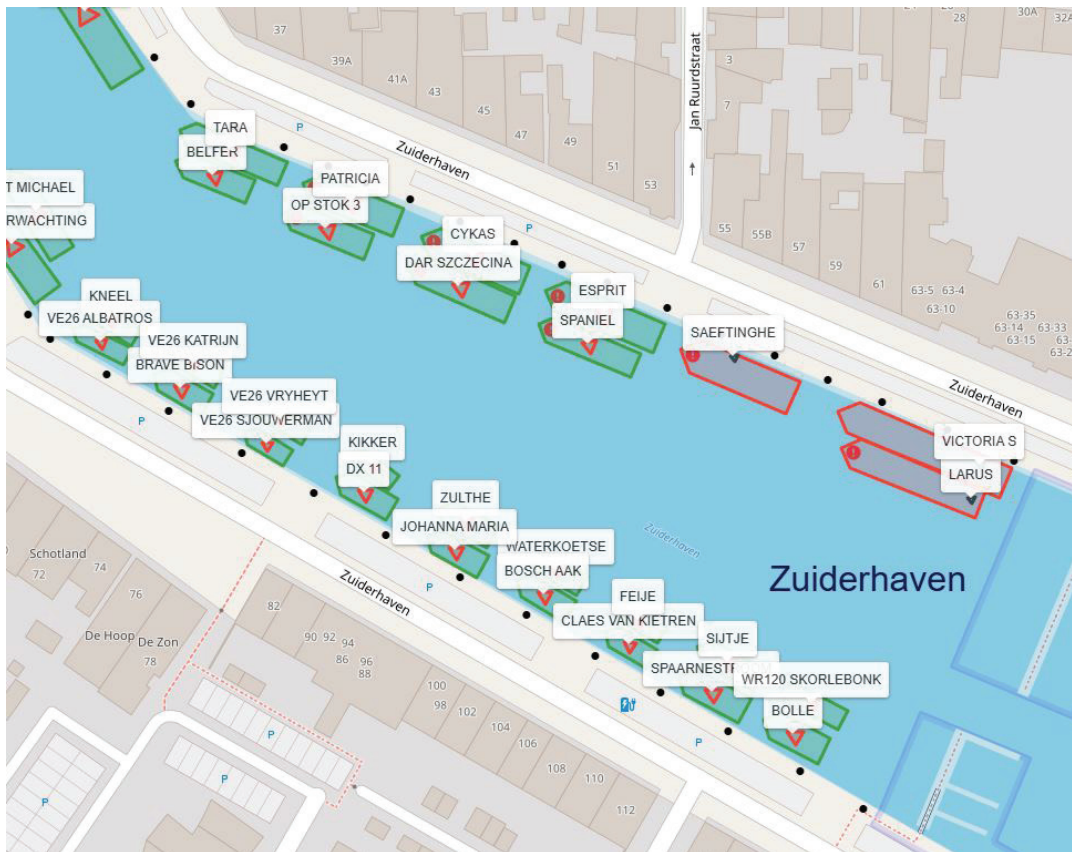
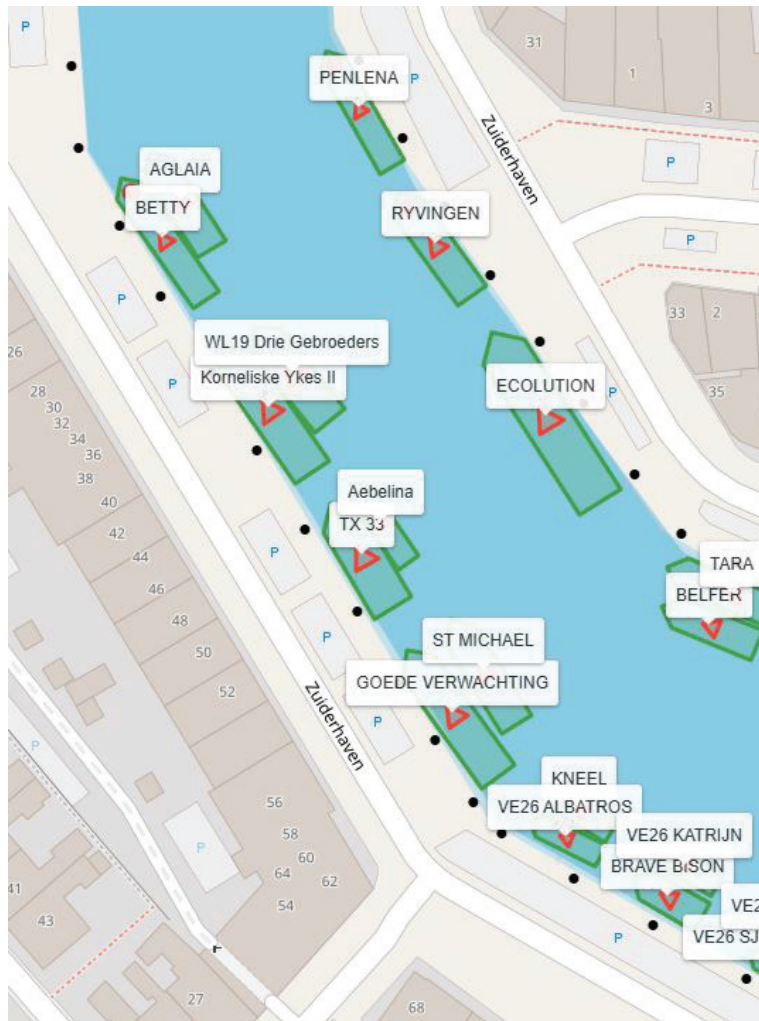

## 4.1 TOWN INFORMATION

Harlingen is a town in the Dutch province of Friesland. It is situated west of Franeker and north-east of the Afsluitdijk. Harlingen belongs to the group of eleven Frisian cities, well-known for the 'Elf Steden Tocht' (Eleven Cities Tour), a 200 km skating tour, which only takes place when the ice is strong enough. The number of inhabitants is around 16,000, the fourth in population size of Friesland.

The port of Harlingen plays an important regional role for shipping: freight, fishing, pleasure craft and shipyards. There are ferry links to the islands of Terschelling and Vlieland. The fleet of around 70 historic sailing ships (the largest fleet in the Netherlands) is iconic for the port of Harlingen. For museums and a museum ship, we refer to section 7.

## 5.4 OPEN SHIP

The Tall Ships Races usually attract hundreds of thousands of visitors during the festivities in the host ports, and there is often huge interest in visiting ships. It is therefore greatly appreciated if ships would open their decks to the public. Whilst it remains at the discretion of the Captain/Master to decide ship opening times, ports have suggested that the following times would be appropriate for ships to be opened to the public.

Times between 11.00 AM and 09.00 PM.

On Sunday, July 5th, a low-stimulus hour will take place from 10:00 to 11:00 AM. This hour is intended for visitors who benefit from a quieter environment, such as people who are sensitive to noise or crowds. Captains/masters are kindly requested to inform their liaison officer and STI on intended open ship policy.

# 6. CREW PROGRAM

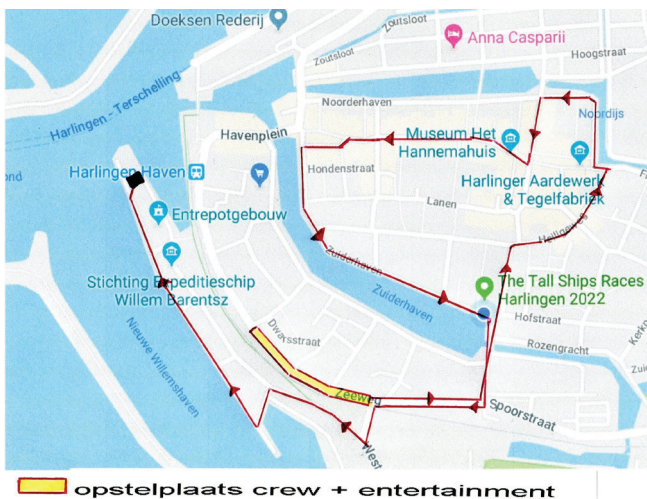
## 6.1 CREW'S PARTY

## Museums in Harlingen, Franeker and Kornwerderzand

### 7.1 HARLINGEN

#### Harlinger Aardewerk & Tegelfabriek

Location: Voorstraat 84

Harlingen is the cradle of Frisian ceramics; since 1598 fine majolica ceramics and tiles have been manufactured in this town. The Harlingen Aardewerk & Tegelfabriek is the last firm in the Netherlands where ceramics and tiles are produced by hand in the traditional way.

During opening hours (except Saturdays or Sundays) you can watch the production of the majolica. Groups of upwards from 8 people can make an appointment for a guided tour (tel: 0031 (0)517 415362)

#### The Willem Barentsz project

De Witte Swaen, expedition ship of Willem Barentsz (1596-1597).

In the year 1596, Willem Barentsz went on an expedition to explore the North-East Passage to China and Japan. Barentsz and his crew were forced by the ice to spend the winter on the northeastern tip of Novaya Zemlya (Nova Zembla). It was a long and extremely cold winter, and they built a wooden house called "Behouden Huys" ('Saved House'). After the winter they sailed back to Holland in two small boats. During that journey Barentsz died.

For 11 years volunteers in Harlingen have been diligently building a replica of Willem Barentsz' expedition ship. In 2018, the ship, the Witte Swaen, was christened and launched. Now she is almost ready to hoist the sails and sail out.

The ship can be visited, and a beautiful exhibition has been set up on the location of the shipyard. Come and have a look!

### **Hannemahuis**

The Hannemahuis Museum, located in the centre of the old harbour city, is housed in a monumental patrician house. The regional museum exhibits objects that are related to the history and art history of Harlingen, and the town's maritime heritage, in particular its role in the whaling industry material on Harlingen's past as a whaling town, which brought so much wealth to Friesland in the 1700s. Other exhibits cover such other noble pursuits as silver crafting and Jenever (Dutch gin) distilling.

### **7.2 FRANEKER**

#### **The Royal Eise Eisinga Planetarium**

The world's oldest working planetarium. Between 1774-1781 Eisinga built an accurate scale model of the solar system in his living room. For more than 240 years all planets, stars sun and moon have been moving exactly as they do in reality. They are all driven by a mechanism of wooden wheels with more than 6.000 nails.

Every visitor receives an explanation in the Planetarium room.

### **7.3 KORNWERDERZAND**

#### **Wadden Center Experience**

Location: Afsluitdijk 1c, Kornwerderzand

The Wadden Center on the Afsluitdijk (Kornwerderzand) is worth a visit. The Wadden Center offers an overview of the Unesco World Heritage Wadden Sea, the unique Fish Migration River, the IJsselmeer Region and, last but not least, the Afsluitdijk itself. Kornwerderzand is located at 8 km from Harlingen.

#### **Kazemattenmuseum**

Location: Afsluitdijk 5, Kornwerderzand

Next to the Wadden Center is the Kazemattenmuseum. In the Kazemattenmuseum you find stories and exhibitions about the period from the construction of the Afsluitdijk to the period of the "Cold War". The aim of these exhibitions is to propagate and keep alive the historical events around Kornwerderzand.

## 9.2 WATER

Fresh water is available at the berths.

There are special water points for the ships; these are indicated on maps and at the location itself. Ships are supposed to use their own hoses as far as possible and the crew to fill their own water tanks. Filling of tanks should be done at night or morning to avoid hoses on the quay. A tank truck is available with limited capacity and only on Friday after berthing and Saturday morning for ships with a large intake capacity for drinking water. For assistance or request contact the technical specialist (see liaison contact list).

## 9.3 ELECTRICITY

Electricity is available to a limited

capacity for all ships without own generator. For specific questions about the capacity and assistance please contact a technical specialist (see liaison contact list).

#### **9.4 WASTE**

Household waste can be placed in closed garbage bags only on the quay next to the gangway immediately after mooring. Waste should be separated as much as possible (glass and paper/cardboard separately). The waste will be collected by the organization as soon as possible. Ships should use their own garbage bags for garbage. The organization tries to be as sustainable as possible, therefore sorting waste is very much appreciated.

Every morning, a round will be made along all ships with a gator vehicle to collect household waste from the ships. Until 09:00, ships have permission to place household waste in sealed bags at the gangway so that it can be collected with gators before the event opening hours.

There are garbage points close to the docks, with several containers (glass, regular garbage and cardboard) big enough to process all the waste derived from the ships and the event-area. These points are available 24 hours per day.

Ships in need for sewage tank emptying have to fill in the form Waste Disposal Notification (see pre arrival set).

## 13.1 GENERAL OVERVIEW OF THE IN-PORT SAFETY ARRANGEMENTS AND KEY DETAILS

All national laws have to be adhered to and each vessel has its own responsibility regarding safety. Also each vessel has to have a safety plan. All shore emergencies should immediately be reported to the National Emergency Phone Number (Ambulance, Fire and Police): 112

Afterwards, please contact your liaison officer who will then report to the Communication Centre and Port Committee.

At sea emergencies should be reported at the Netherlands Coastguard VHF CH 16.

At Waddenzee contact VTS Brandaris VHF CH 2

Afterwards, please contact your Liaison Officer who will then report to the Communication Centre and Port Committee

## 13.2 COVID-19 MITIGATION

Due to the corona pandemic, the health of participants, employees and the public is a special point of attention. The focus of the corona measures will therefore be on land, under the direction of the safety task force on land, in which the GGD (public health

service)/GHOR (regional organization of medical assistance at accidents and disasters) is also represented.

However, as a port authority, Port of Harlingen has a role in reporting formalities by the visiting and participating ships. These ships are required by law to submit a Maritime Declaration of Health to the port authority before arrival. Port of Harlingen passes on reported infections to the GGD Friesland, which coordinates further measures.

## 14.2 MAJOR INCIDENTS (FIRE, EXPLOSION, MAN OVERBOARD ETC.)

The Coast Guard is responsible for Search and Rescue on the Waddenzee. The Dutch Lifeboat Association (KNRM) deploys extra lifeboats during the Sail-in and the Sail-out. During the regular activities, the lifeboats are coordinated by the SAR-liaison.

In the docks SAR is a regular task for the fire department. As the KNRM is standby in the harbour during the day, the first deployment will be by lifeboats. This deployment is the responsibility of the fire department and the lifeboats will have firefighting equipment on board.

### Boarding and landing locations

The following locations will be in use during Sail:

Location 1: Vluchthaven. This is the primary location, next to one of the fire stations and the Medical Relief Organisation (GHOR).

Location 2: Sportvissteiger. This is an alternative location, only used in consultation with the officer on duty (OVD) or the Incident Site Command.

### Fire on board

In case of fire on board, the first deployment will always be by water, in light of the limited road access. A unit of fire fighters will be directed to the incident from Location 1 (Vluchthaven). Thus, firefighting vehicles will have a longer response time. Transport of firefighters is primarily a task of the KNRM. When no vessels are available, the On Scene Coordinator OCW designates an alternative vessel for transport of the firefighters.

### Medical Care on water

The lifeboats of the KNRM have extensive First-Aid equipment on board and the crew members are trained for first aid at a high level. Victims/patients are landed at Location 1: Vluchthaven. In consultation with the medical officer on duty there are two alternative locations: Location 2: sportvissteiger.

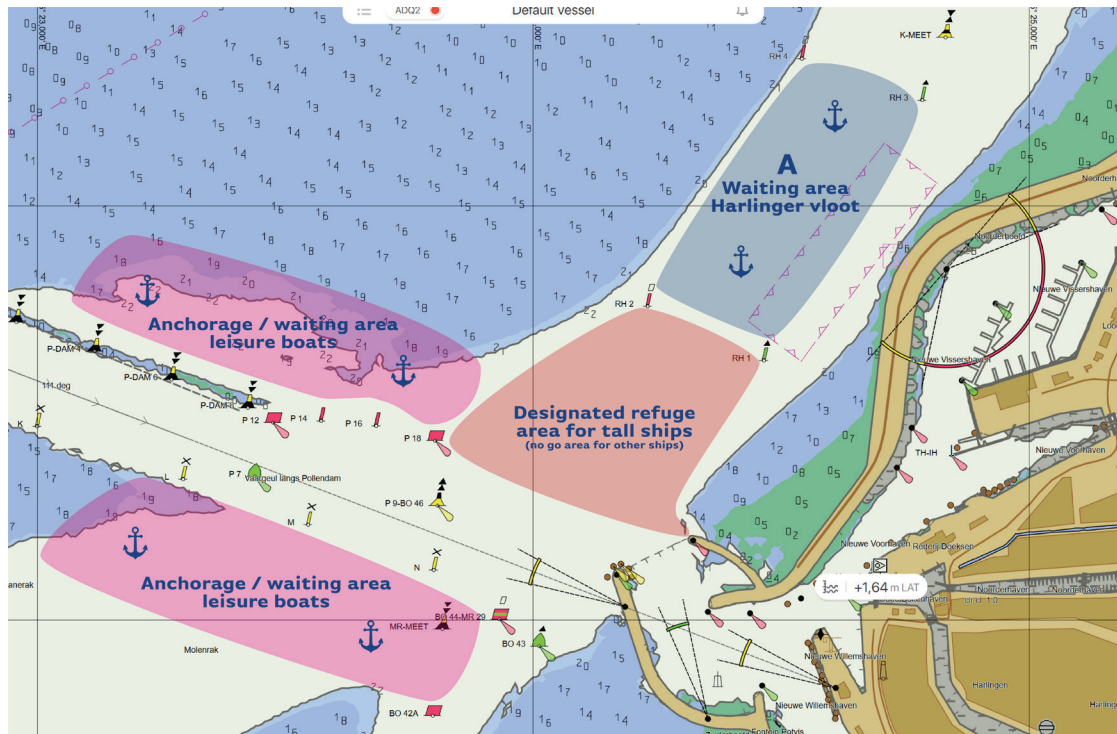

2. If a vessel qualifies based on the Decree of the Dutch Ministry of Finance of 13 November 2018, nr. 2018-155014 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2019 13 (hereinafter: ‘the Decree’), the VAT rate amounts to 0%. Should the vessel not qualify, the VAT rate amounts to 21%.
3. Services provided to a vessel qualify for application of the VAT rate of 0% in case the vessel
  - 1) is entirely used for commercial purposes; and 2) is used for more than 70% for shipping on open sea and:
    1. *with which passenger transport takes place against payment; or*
    2. *is used for performing an industrial, commercial or fishing activity.*
4. On our invoices we will take into account the VAT rate of 0% and will mention that Client declares by way of payment of our invoice that the conditions for applying the 0% VAT rate, as set out in the Decree, have been met.
5. If the conditions as set out in the Decree are not met, Client should inform us hereon upfront so that we can send an invoice including the VAT rate of 21%.
6. If it appears that the vessel does not qualify under the Decree and the VAT rate of 0% have been taken into account unfounded, the VAT rate of 21% will be invoiced to Client and paid to the Dutch tax authorities. This invoice will also include legal tax interest and penalties, if any.
