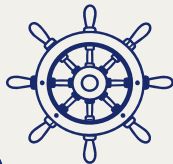
We have always looked to the sea. For food, for work, for travelling and transportation, for connecting with nature, for frolicking and fun, for friends visiting from far-away lands. Being the energy capital of Norway, the city has always had an international orientation.

The Stavanger region is Norway's third largest urban region, with a population of around 350,000. In the city centre, it won't feel like it, though. Stavanger has the charm of a small town with its cobbled streets, old wooden houses and medieval cathedral. Postcard charm aside, the city also offers a vibrant cultural scene with concerts and events, and cutting-edge street art pieces to admire, some larger-than-life, some tiny and hidden.

We can't live on arts and culture alone. Foodies have plenty of reasons to enjoy Stavanger. The city prides itself on being a culinary hot spot with an array of restaurants and eateries serving up everything from street food to three-star Michelin delicacies. Most of the produce is locally sourced; fresh seafood, seasonal fruit and vegetables and lamb are just some of the specialties.

The landscape is typically Norwegian: Forests, fjords, miles and miles of sandy white beaches, perfect for surfing. Further inland, the gently rolling hills give way to breathtaking mountains: A timeless backdrop to a modern and innovative city region.

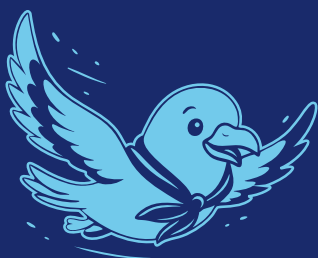

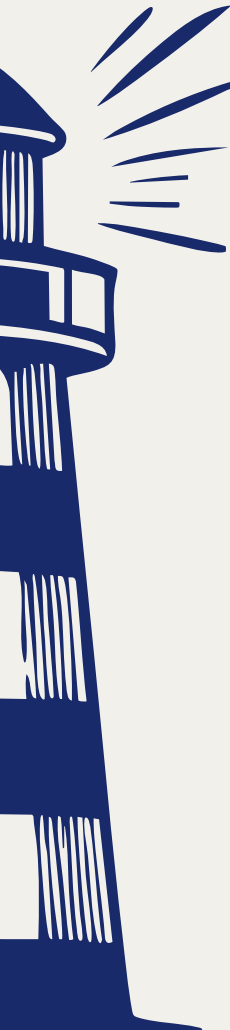
WIFI:

CHURCH SERVICE:

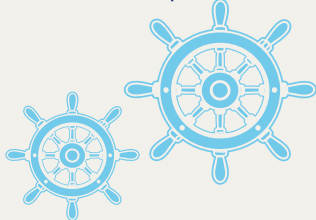
Stavanger Cathedral ([Domkirken](#)) invites all Tall Ships crew to an ecumenical service.

When: Saturday 25 July at 11:00-11:25.

The service will be conducted in Norwegian and English.

MEMORIAL PROCESSION:

There will be a memorial procession for sailors lost at sea from the Cathedral to the harbour Saturday 25 July at 11:25, where a wreath will be handed over to tall ship Pascual Flores on the Skagenkaiaen quay. All crew are welcome to take part.





CREW PARADE AND PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY:

The Crew Parade will take place on Thursday 23 July at 16:00 -17:00. The parade will include a stop where all ships are encouraged to greet their crew with the ship's whistle. Inform your crew on watch and ask them to be on standby to blow the ship's whistle.

Where: From the [Petroleum Museum](#) along the quayside to the [Concert Hall](#) main stage

What to bring: Elements making the parade fun for both crew and spectators.

The Prize Giving Ceremony starts immediately after the Crew Parade from the main stage, Concert Hall arena.

PLEASE NOTE:

Prizes will also be given for "BEST ARRIVAL" to Stavanger, various Crew Parade performances and crew activity results.

CREW PARTY:

Thursday 23 July at 19:00-23:00

Where: [Bjergsted Park](#), by the old Concert Hall, within walking distance from the harbour.

The lovely Bjergsted park is the ideal location for the Stavanger crew party. Dress up, bring your best party spirit, and join us for an unforgettable evening with music, games, delicious food, refreshing drinks and an open bar.

Admission is restricted to those wearing TSR2026 wristband and Crew Party wristband: White (under 18) and blue (over 18) with food (1) and drink (2 and 3) tokens. Please note that there will be strict regulations on alcohol in line with Norwegian legislation. Alcohol will be available for purchase only for those able to prove that they are over 18 years old. Bringing your own alcoholic drinks to the party is not allowed.

Crew Party regulations:

- ONLY crew with TSR2026 wristband AND Crew Party wristband will be allowed into the party area.
- Crew without both wristbands when in the party area will be asked to leave immediately.
- Anyone over 18 supplying alcohol to under 18s or anyone under 18 drinking alcohol in the party area will be asked to leave immediately.
- Crew over 18 will have to show Crew Party wristband and ID to be served any alcohol.
